## The Weather

**Today:** Showers and thunderstorms are a 100% possibility today with a high near 69° and E-SE wind 5-15 mph and gusting to 20. The chance of rain includes possible accumulations of 3 to 4 inches today.

**Tonight:** Rain chances of 70% continue up to 1am in the morning. Rainfall could be a half to ¾ in. as the rain system leaves the area. The low temp should be 57°.

**Thursday:** The sun comes back out and all rain chances disappear ahead of schedule, allowing for planned activities, from ball games to rodeos and other outdoor events to go ahead with plans. The wind will be northerly (remember the rain came with a cool front) and it will be getting up to 10-15 mph.

Overnight, this front will bring the temperature down to 56° under the clear sky and with a 5-10 mph north wind.

**Rest of the week:** Friday sunshine reveals the coming nice weekend as the wind shifts around to east in the afternoon and then to south by Saturday morning. The high Friday will be 79°.
