## The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Friday** shows a reported fraud in the 1300 block of CTE at 11:56am, then a theft reported in the 200 block of Riverview Dr. at 1:35pm. A minor accident took place in the 1400 block of S. Key Ave. at 3:52pm. Later in the evening, Anthony Crowley Jr., 40, of Lampasas was arrested at 9:22pm in the 900 block of W. 4<sup>th</sup> St. for possession of marijuana less than 2 oz., and possession of drug paraphernalia. There was a noise complaint in the 2300 block of 281S at 10:20pm, and suspicious activity was reported at the same location at 10:55pm.

**The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. Blotter** for Friday shows Kempner tending to civil matters, a reported trespassing, a requested welfare check and reports of suspicious activity. Out in the county there was an accident, livestock issues and a reported disturbance. Deputies went into Cove on a livestock issue.

**The County Jail Log** shows the arrest of 25 year old Jose Gonzalez, of Lampasas on a bond revocation.

**The Burn Ban has been lifted until May 7th**

These items include:

household batteries, fuel containers and flashlights priced at less than \$75; hurricane shutters and emergency ladders priced at less than \$300; and portable generators priced at less than \$3,000. For purchases made online, note that delivery, shipping, handling and transportation charges are part of the sales price. If the emergency preparation supply being purchased is taxable, the delivery charge is also taxable. Consider these charges when determining whether an emergency preparation supply can be purchased tax-free during the holiday.

For example, if you purchase a rescue ladder for \$299 with a \$10 delivery charge, the total sales price is \$309. Because the total sales price of the ladder is more than \$300, tax is due on the \$309 sales price.

Several over-the-counter self-care items, such as antibacterial hand sanitizer, soap, spray and wipes, are always exempt from sales tax if they are labeled with a "Drug Facts" panel in accordance with federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regulations.

Purchases that do not qualify include: batteries for automobiles, boats and other motorized vehicles; camping stoves and camping supplies; chainsaws; plywood; extension ladders and stepladders; and tents. A list of emergency preparation supplies that may be purchased tax-free can be found on the Comptroller's website.

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet Monday evening for regularly scheduled meetings. The Workshop session at 5:30pm will include; updates on COVID-19, the mural on the Calvert Municipal Building, discussion of livestock and fowl in the City of Lampasas, and the summer pool start-up and schedule.



Council will then move into Executive Session, for discussion regarding potential or threatened litigation related to possible breach of contract for us of public right-of-way, and other matters. Council will then move into Special Session for possible action concerning items discussed in Executive Session.

The Agenda for the regular session includes the consent agenda, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of an ordinance approving a SUP for 809 E. 4<sup>th</sup> St. to allow for mini-warehouses.
