Burnet Police Sgt. Charged With 1st Degree Murder



On Tuesday in Burnet a Grand Jury true-billed the officer (left) that, on March 27th, shot 3 times into a car, killing 25 yr old Brandon Michael Jacque, a 2011 graduate of Burnet High School where he played football, baseball and ran track. Jacque was buried April 2nd,

leaving behind a daughter, parents and siblings.

The incident started early, at 1:40am that morning, when police were called about loud music being played at an address in the 300 block of S. McNeil in Burnet. At the scene, Police Sgt. Russell Butler found a red car in a driveway that was backing out. He reportedly called for the driver to stop but the car kept moving and the tire ran over the officer's foot. When that happened the officer reportedly fired into the vehicle, killing the driver, Jacque, but not hitting a young female passenger.

After the shooting Sgt. Butler reportedly attempted first aid and called for the EMS but they were unable to revive Jacque. Butler was taken to Burnet's Seton Hospital about his foot but X-Rays taken there showed no broken bones and he was treated and released.

After the incident, Police Chief Paul Nelson said that Patrol Sgt. Butler had been with the department for three years, but was placed on administrative leave pending investigation by Texas Rangers.

As a result of the investigation, the matter went to the Grand Jury Tuesday and a true-bill handed down, charging him with 1st degree murder and 3 counts of 1st degree aggravated assault, all coming out of the same incident. Butler turned himself in and went to the Llano Co. Jail where he was arraigned and posted bond.

At the same time, a release went out from the Burnet PD and the City of Burnet saying that Russell Butler had been released of duty with the PD, due to policy violations, as of that same day, Tuesday.



Private Plane Crashes in Kingsland Two men are dead.

According to DPS Sgt Robbie Barrera, a single engine propeller aircraft took off from the River Valley Ranch airstrip in Kingsland on Sunday with two occupants.

For unknown reasons the aircraft crashed shortly after takeoff and both occupants died at the scene. The FAA is investigating the crash.

The deceased are William Lee Glenn, 69 of Kingsland and John Timothy Sharpe of Kingsland.

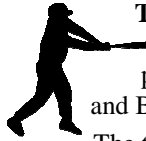
