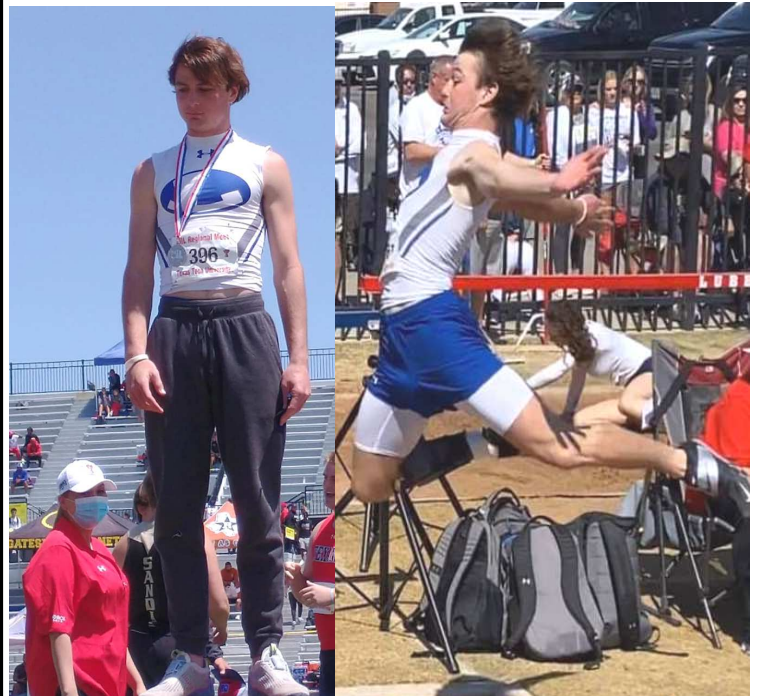
### Badger Track
