Rabies in Lampasas County

From Lampasas Animal Control: "We have had 3 Positive Rabies cases in Lampasas County in the last month. We cannot stress enough how important it is to keep your animals currently vaccinated. Rabies is required to be done on all dogs and cats by 4 months old age. While the county does recognize a 3 year vaccination, if your vet certifies it for the 3 years, animals that are coming in contact with wildlife should be done yearly. We also strongly recommend vaccinating your livestock. Please call and speak with your Vet to check the status of your pets. Rabies vaccinations can only be done at your Vet's office. It cannot be bought over the counter.

If you see an animal acting strangely, please call Animal Control. Animals out during the daytime is not always a symptom of rabies, they could be just looking for food. Other more important symptoms would be walking strangely or stumbling, drooling or biting at the air, sudden change in behavior (wild animal suddenly nice, friendly dog suddenly aggressive), and unprovoked attacks.

Rabid Skunk found 3600 Block of Big Divide Rd. (April 22nd)

Please know that rabies is still ongoing issue in Texas and fatal if contracted in animals AND PEOPLE. Please report any and all animal bites so that rabies risk can be assessed."



Saratoga Underground WCD Hearing

The Saratoga Underground Water Conservation District will hold a public hearing to discuss, consider, receive public comments, and potentially act upon adoption of amendments to the District's Rules for water wells in Lampasas County. The proposed amendments to the rules include changes and or/additions related to the following:

Definitions, registration of wells, permitting requirements and exemptions, metering, spacing, location, and completion of wells, recordkeeping, reporting of usage, payment of fees, groundwater availability certifications, production limitations, aquifer storage and recovery wells, hearing and appeals processes, enforcement and penalties for violation the rules and organizational and conforming changes.

The hearing will be held on Monday May 16th at 10am at the Lampasas County Court House 1st floor Commissioners' Courtroom. Any person who desires to appear at the hearing to present comments may do so in person, at the hearing, by legal representative or in writing to PO Box 168 Lampasas Texas 76550. At the conclusion of the hearing or any time or date thereafter, the proposed rules may be adopted in the form presented or as amended based upon comments received from the public, District staff, consultants or members of the board.
