

The Weather



In Lampasas Radio Studios

Lampasas City Manager Finley de Graffenried joined Ronnie Witcher in Lampasas Radio Studios this morning.

They visited about the renovation of the Hostess House and the new scope of the project, and ensuring that all the necessary upgrades are included. The city will revisit the bid process sometime in July.

The City Council discussed a utility rate increase for city utility customers at Monday night's meeting. Mr. de Graffenried spoke about how much the electric market has changed in the past few years. External impacts such as the wholesale price of electric and the cost of belonging to ERCOT have caused rate increases for the city. While the city has held off on a rate increase thus far, they will have to begin passing that expense on to the customer. The City Council will discuss the rate change at the next meeting and the change will take effect 30 days after that.

The City Manager spoke about the funds that the city receives from the Hotel-Motel-Tax, and different ways the city can utilize those funds, including part of the Hostess House Rehabilitation as well as Capital Improvement Projects.




