## The Weather

**The High yesterday 82° The Low this morning 61°**

A dryline will be moving through west Texas this afternoon, creating instability. That instability, along with daytime heating should produce scattered storms in front of the dryline. Most of the activity should be to our west, but could move east after dark. Some storms could be strong, but will weaken the farther east they travel. Tuesday sees storm chances from late afternoon through the overnight hours. Some of these could be strong or severe, before moving out of the area Wednesday morning, leaving us with quiet weather conditions.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 85°. Wind will be S at 10-20 mph, gusting to 25 mph.

**Tonight:** Increasing clouds overnight with a low near 68°, and a slight chance of showers very early in the overnight hours. The winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph.

**Tuesday:** Cloudy skies clearing as the day goes on, and a high temperature near 90°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Mostly cloudy with a low temperature near 67°. There is a 40% chance of showers and storms very early Wednesday morning. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph decreasing overnight.

**Wednesday:** Cloudy with a 30% chance of storms early in the morning. Then skies will clear for a mostly sunny day with a high near 83°. Wind will be NE at 5-15 mph.

**Wednesday Night:** Clear skies with a low near 55°. Winds will be light out of the N-NE.

## Lampasas Graduate Killed in Accident.

This from the Killeen Daily Herald: "BELTON — Bell County Sheriff's Department Deputy John Andrew Rhoden, 31, lost his life in the line of duty in a vehicle-pedestrian accident about 1:45 a.m. Sunday, Lt. Robert A. Reinhard, BCSD spokesman, said in a news release.

Bell County Sheriff's deputies were asked to assist the Williamson County Sheriff's Office in the pursuit of a stolen vehicle, according to Reinhard's release and a separate news release from Cody Weems, spokesman for Temple Police Department. Rhoden was attempting to lay spike strips along northbound Interstate 35, near the FM 93 exit ramp, when a semitrailer truck struck him, the reports said.

Bell County Justice of the Peace David Barfield ordered an autopsy from the Dallas County Medical Examiner's Office. Rhoden's body will be escorted to Dallas by members of the BCSD, including some from his patrol shift, Reinhard said.

The accident is being investigated by the Texas Department of Public Safety, the Temple Police Department's Accident Reconstruction Unit, and BCSD."

Born in Norwood, Mass., Rhoden graduated from Lampasas High School in 2005, and started his career with the BCSD in June 2010. He was promoted to field deputy in August 2014 and was currently assigned to the midnight shift patrol division.

## Commissioners Meeting

The Lampasas County Commissioners had their regularly scheduled meeting today at 9am. The meeting was broadcasted due to social distancing guidelines.

The consent agenda was accepted and there were no public comments.

LA Porter construction was awarded the bid for Non Spec/Spec Flex Base. The final plat for the Milam Subdivision was tabled. A request to place 3 patrol cars and 1 animal control unit in an auction was approved. A resolution was approved to apply for a grant from the Fort Hood Area Habitat for Humanity. Also approved was the purchase of 3 additional electronic poll books. A bid was approved in the amount of \$11,621 for repair of the Annex I and Annex II awnings.

## City Council Meets

The Lampasas City Council will hold its regular meeting tonight in City Council Chambers.

The workshop session begins at 5:30pm and will include an update regarding COVID-19, and discussion regarding any item on the regular agenda.

The regular session begins at 6pm. The agenda includes the consent agenda, departmental reports, and routine matters. In new business there will be discussion regarding the adoption of the LEDC Business Emergency Grant Program by a resolution of the Lampasas City Council, and discussion regarding the City of Lampasas Emergency Declaration.

The City Council will meet in Executive Session after the regular meeting, "to receive and evaluate financial information received from a business prospect" and to discuss or deliberate financial information that the city has received from a business prospect that the city seeks to locate/stay/expand in or near the city with which the city is conducting economic development negotiations. Or to deliberate any offer of any financial or other incentives to any business prospect as described above. The Council also may have a consultation with an attorney.

Council will then return to regular session for discussion and possible action concerning what transpired in Executive Session.
