The Weather



The high yesterday 75° This morning's low 55°

Today: Look for increasing clouds with a high temperature near 88° and a 50% chance of showers and storms this afternoon with some possibly severe. Wind will be S at 10-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph shifting to the N-NW this evening.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies tonight and the low temperature will be near 51°. There is a 40% chance of showers and storms with some severe. Gusty N-NW wind near 20-25 mph gusting to 40 mph.

Saturday: Look for sunny skies and a high temperature near 70°. Wind will be N-NW at 15-25 mph and could gust as high as 35 mph.

Saturday Night: Look for clear skies with a low temperature near 49°. N-NW wind near 5-15 mph could gust as high as 20 mph and will shift to the W overnight.

Sunday: Sunny skies with and the high temperature will be near 84°. Wind will be W near 5-10 mph becoming S in the afternoon.

Sunday Night: Clear skies with a low temperature near 56°. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.




