## The Weather



The High yesterday 78° The Low this morning 48°

After a cool start today, temperatures should rebound to seasonal highs. The forecasters say that Friday through Monday, a dryline will move eastward into our western counties. This will cause high temperatures in the upper 90's maybe even in the 100°-102° range ahead of an expected cold front.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 84°. The wind will be W near 5 mph becoming S-SE in the afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear with a low near 59° and light E-SE winds becoming S-SW after midnight.

**Friday:** Sunny skies with a high temperature near 89°. Winds will be S-SW near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Friday Night:** Skies will be partly cloudy with a low near 64°. Winds will be S near 10 mph.

**Saturday:** Mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 93°. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph.

**Saturday Night:** 68° with partly cloudy skies, and S wind near 10 mph.

## DPS Trooper in Studio

DPS Trooper Sgt. Bryan Washko was in the Lampasas Radio Studios this morning. One of the items covered during his interview was distracted driving. According to the Texas Department of Transportation, there were more than 96,000 crashes involving distracted driving in 2018, and these crashes led to more than 2,300 serious injuries and over 390 deaths.

DPS wants to remind you that distracted driving of any kind can be dangerous. In just three seconds, when you take your eyes off of the road while driving at 70 mph, your vehicle travels over the length of a football field. (102 feet per second). Distractions are anything that take a driver's attention off the road, including talking on the phone.

To put it in context, Sgt. Washko stated that if you drive while intoxicated you are 20 times more likely to have an accident. If you text and drive, you are 23 times more likely to have an accident. Keep your eyes on the road!

Put your phone away or turn it off before getting behind the wheel.

Sgt. Washko also talked about the decrease in traffic due to

COVID-19, which caused a decrease in traffic accidents. Troopers are also having to navigate how they do traffic stops now, due to concerns about becoming infected. He now has people hold up their license so he can get the information as opposed to handling someone's license and information.



## Lampasas Police Dept. Makes Multiple Arrests

Lampasas Radio received the following press releases from the Lampasas Police Dept.

**On Tuesday, April 28, 2020**, at approximately 2:54 pm, Lampasas Police Department Communications Officer Mary Mendez received a report of a vehicle being driven in a reckless manner, driving the wrong direction into oncoming traffic. The vehicle was reported to be traveling north bound on S Hwy 183, just south of the City of Lampasas.

Lampasas Police Department Officer Joshua Watson was dispatched to the call and upon observing the vehicle, turned to make a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle attempted to run from and evade Officer Watson by causing the vehicle to make evasive turns and traveling at high rates of speed.

Officer Watson was able to follow the vehicle, until it stopped in the 2200 block of South Hwy 183. Officer Watson noticed the vehicle had been abandoned by the driver and the driver had continued to try to evade Officer Watson on foot.

The driver was located by Officers and taken into custody by Lt. Charles Montgomery in the field between South 183 and the Old Austin Highway (County Road 4006).

The driver was arrested for Evading Arrest/Detention and Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from the Austin, Texas area.

Lampasas Police Department Sergeant Investigators Nicholas Roberts and Tim Ryan conducted the follow-up investigation regarding this case.

# Kindergarten Round Up



Lampasas ISD is having their annual Pre-K/Kindergarten Round Up beginning May 12<sup>th</sup> at Kline Whitis. Hanna Springs will be May 13<sup>th</sup>, and Taylor Creek will be holding their Kindergarten Round Up on

May 14<sup>th</sup>. On the days specified, the schools will be open from 9am to 6pm for legal guardians to register their children. If your child will be 5 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, they will be eligible for Kindergarten. If the child turns 4 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, they can apply for Pre-K.

Pre-K students must qualify for enrollment based on state guidelines.

Parents/Guardians should bring a copy of the students shot record, birth certificate, social security card, proof of residence, (utility bill), and a photo ID of the person enrolling the child. If you have any questions, please call the campus you will be registering at.
