The High yesterday 77° The Low this morning 73°



Today: An 80% chance of rain with possible thunderstorms and 3/4 to an inch of rain also a possibility. The high should be around 76° and the wind S-SE at 10-15 mph with gusts to 20.

Tonight: 80% rain chances before 2am with possibly heavy rain and rainstorms. A 3/4 to an inch of rainfall is possible. The low temp should be about 67° with the SE wind at 10-15 mph.

Thursday: The rain chance drops to 40% for the day, mainly in the afternoon, and that rises back to 60% overnight. The wind continues to be southerly and temperatures remain warm with a daytime high of 81° and overnight dropping to 65°.

Rest of the week: Friday rain chances are seen to be 70% with possibly heavy rain. The 70% chance is also seen for Friday night when the wind shifts around to N-NE. Friday's high should be upper 70s and low 60s overnight.

Saturday seems to clear up a little with only a 40% chance of rain and that is before 2pm. It drops to 20% after that. The high should be about 81° and the low 61°.

Sunday should bring sunshine back but it will be warm with mid-80s and plenty of humidity. Watch for mud, mosquitoes, and a sweltering afternoon

They played amazingly well.

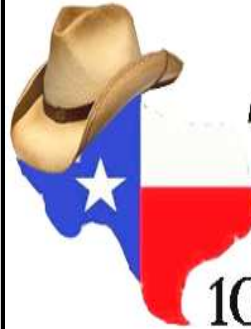
