## Lampasas ISD School Board to Meet

**The Lampasas ISD School Board** will meet today at 6pm at the Lampasas ISD Administration Building at 207 W. 8<sup>th</sup> St. in Lampasas.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda, to include a budget amendment, notification of resignation of professional personnel, selection of professional personnel, instructional materials allotment and TEKS certification for 2023-2024 and the Superintendent's authority to hire professional personnel from May 2<sup>nd</sup>-August 31<sup>st</sup> 2023.

Also on the agenda is the updated employee contract forms, employee donated local leave days, administrative reports to include enrollment, curriculum/instruction and business support services. A long term facility plan review is on the agenda, as well as a report of student enrollment growth in LISD, a memorandum of understanding between Clayton Ranch Phase I and LISD for sidewall connections at Taylor Creek Elementary, and a possible consultation with attorney regarding Petition for Detachment and Annexation.

## Lampasas High Art Students at State Competition

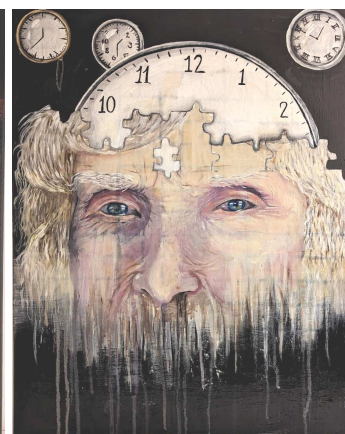
Congratulations to Lampasas High School Senior Tate Brown. Tate won the GOLD SEAL award at the State VASE Competition, the highest honor which is given to only 1% of the exhibits. Tate won with her work, "The Unruly Mind".

Judith Brown, Fine Arts Teacher at Lampasas High School said "This is HUGE". There were 31,000 total entries, 2071 state finalists, and 151 of those finalists received the Gold Seal Award. The Texas Art Education Association (TAEA) states that judges look for artworks that represent exemplary examples of concept,

technique, craftsmanship and creativity. Students who are awarded the Gold Seal Award receive a Gold State Medallion and their artwork will be exhibited in a variety of venues across the state culminating with the Gold Seal Exhibition at the annual TAEA Fall Conference. Tate's work (*below right*) will travel Texas for the next year.

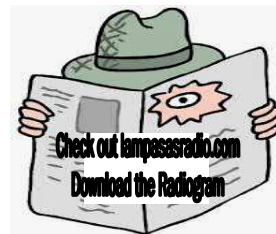
