High yesterday was 73° (at 2am Thursday morning)

The low this morning was 61°

Rainfall at the airport gauge Thursday was .01in. Rainfall at the airport gauge this AM was 1.39 in. Rainfall at Lometa LCRA gauge this AM was .28 in Rainfall 10 mi WSW of Lampasas this AM was 2.06in Rainfall at Burnet LCRA gauge this AM was 3.22 in.

Today: The sun came out this morning, but the forecast of a 90% rain chance fears the systems moving NE up through the state. That appears to drop as the day goes. The high should be about 74° in the sunny parts of the day. The wind will be light and SE.

Tonight: Rain is a 60% chance early this evening, then clearing and the temperature dropping to 61° with light wind out of the east.

Saturday: Partly sunny, with a high near 78°, but the wind will be out of the north and very light. That light wind will spare us too much cold, but the evening temperature should drop into the upper 50s overnight. Any ball game plans Saturday and Saturday evening should include jackets.

Sunshine will rule on Sunday for the most part. The high should reach the low 80s.

The above should change fast on Monday as the rain clouds come back into the area into mid-week.
