### **Local Election Results**

**TJ Monroe** won the mayoral election Saturday for the City of Lampasas, by 71 votes. Clayton Tucker lost out for Place 1 to Zac Morris. Randy Clark, Place 2, and Herb Pearce, Place 6 ran uncontested. The votes will be canvassed on May 10<sup>th</sup> and new members will be sworn in on May 24<sup>th</sup>.

**Kempner is seeing big changes** as JW Wilkerson won over incumbent Keith Harvey for Mayor of Kempner by a total of 99 votes. Rob Green, Place 3, and Dan Long, place 4 ran unopposed. The Mayor-Elect is tentatively scheduling a special meeting on Friday May 7<sup>th</sup> to canvass the votes.

**Lometa had 3 at-large places open**, and Johnny Towerton, James Dickison, and Marsha Laughlin won those spots. The votes will be canvassed on May 10<sup>th</sup> and the new members will also be sworn in on May d10<sup>th</sup>.

### **Meetings Today**

**The Lampasas County Commissioner's Court** met this morning at 8:30am in the County Annex Building in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor conference room. On the workshop agenda is discussion, consideration and taking possible action on the Lampasas County Subdivision regulations.

Lampasas ISD School Board will meet at 6pm. The Agenda includes; the consent agenda, notices of resignations and notices of selections for professional personnel and teachers. Also on the agenda is a requested change to the July Board Meeting date to July 12, 2021, a CPR waiver, , some administrative reports will be presented and there is time set aside for consultation with the attorney on the Petition for Detachment and Annexation, as well as Real Property matters.

## **Road Closings**

The BNSF Railway will close a section of FM 581

(Main Street) in Lometa on Monday, May 3, 2021 to perform maintenance on a railroad crossing beginning at 7am today. Work is expected to be completed by 5pm tomorrow. Motorists are encouraged to avoid this area and



can follow the detour route of US 183 south, to US 281 north to Adamsville and then south on FM 581.

The Crossing on 580E/Ave J will be closed Wednesday beginning at 7am, work is expected to be completed by 5pm that same day. Traffic will be detoured to 183S, to 190E, to FM1715 then back to 580E.
