

The Weather



The High yesterday 86° The Low this morning 66°

Today: Sunny skies and a high temperature near 92°. Winds will be SW at 5-10 mph with possible gusts as high as 20 mph. The forecasters are looking for showers and storms this afternoon, however forecasting the timing is proving to be a bit of a challenge. Between 5am and 7pm in our area is the best guess at this time.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds and a low temperature near 61°. Winds will become N in the overnight, and there is a 30% chance of showers and storms. The front should clear our area around 6am on Tuesday.

Tuesday: Look for mostly cloudy skies with decreasing clouds and a very slight chance of showers. The high temperature will be near 74°. Winds will be N at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Tuesday Night: Clear skies with a low temperature near 51°, and winds will be N at 5-15 with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny skies and a high near 76°. Winds will become calm in the morning.

Rest of the week: look for dry conditions, and nice weather with highs in the 80's and lows in the 50's

Local Election Results

TJ Monroe won the mayoral election Saturday for the City of Lampasas, by 71 votes. Clayton Tucker lost out for Place 1 to Zac Morris. Randy Clark, Place 2, and Herb Pearce, Place 6 ran uncontested. The votes will be canvassed on May 10th and new members will be sworn in on May 24th.

Kempner is seeing big changes as JW Wilkerson won over incumbent Keith Harvey for Mayor of Kempner by a total of 99 votes. Rob Green, Place 3, and Dan Long, place 4 ran unopposed. The Mayor-Elect is tentatively scheduling a special meeting on Friday May 7th to canvass the votes.

Lometa had 3 at-large places open, and Johnny Towerton, James Dickson, and Marsha Laughlin won those spots. The votes will be canvassed on May 10th and the new members will also be sworn in on May 24th.

Meetings Today

The Lampasas County Commissioner's Court met this morning at 8:30am in the County Annex Building in the 1st floor conference room. On the workshop agenda is discussion, consideration and taking possible action on the Lampasas County Subdivision regulations.

Lampasas ISD School Board will meet at 6pm. The Agenda includes; the consent agenda, notices of resignations and notices of selections for professional personnel and teachers. Also on the agenda is a requested change to the July Board Meeting date to July 12, 2021, a CPR waiver, some administrative reports will be presented and there is time set aside for consultation with the attorney on the Petition for Detachment and Annexation, as well as Real Property matters.

Road Closings

The BNSF Railway will close a section of FM 581

(Main Street) in Lometa on Monday, May 3, 2021 to perform maintenance on a railroad crossing beginning at 7am today. Work is expected to be completed by 5pm tomorrow. Motorists are encouraged to avoid this area and can follow the detour route of US 183 south, to US 281 north to Adamsville and then south on FM 581.



The Crossing on 580E/Ave J will be closed Wednesday beginning at 7am, work is expected to be completed by 5pm that same day. Traffic will be detoured to 183S, to 190E, to FM1715 then back to 580E.

The following railroad crossings will be undergoing repair; this Thursday May 6th will see CR 2200 closed at the railroad crossing, Monday May 10th will see CR 2021 and CR 3010 closing. E. 3rd Street in Lampasas will be closed Tuesday the 11th, as well as CR 2060. Wednesday May 12, will see the Oak St. crossing in Lometa closed, and Thursday the 13th FM 1715 will be closed for repairs.

Lampasas Community Development Grant

The City of Lampasas is giving notice of the city's intent to submit a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program grant application for a Community Development Fund grant request of \$350,000 for water system improvements in the northeast area of the city, generally bounded by Western Ave., Northington St., Avenue F, and 3rd St. The application is available for review at the City Hall during regular business hours.
