### The Weather



#### The high yesterday 80° This morning's low 57°

Today: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 83°. There will be a light E-SE wind near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Partly cloudy skies and the low temperature will dip to near 63°. Wind will be E-SE near 5-10 mph shifting S-SW overnight.

Thursday: Skies will be partly sunny with a high temperature near 85°. There is a 30% chance of precipitation in the afternoon. Wind will be S near 5-10 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly cloudy skies with a low near 68° and a 30% chance of showers late in the evening. The wind will be from the S near 15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Friday**: Skies will be mostly sunny with a high temperature near 91° and a 20% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. SW winds will be near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly cloudy skies and the low temperature will be near 67°. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

### **In Lampasas Radio Studios**

Ryan Ward, Assistant Lampasas City Manager was at Lampasas Radio Studios this morning for a visit with Ronnie Witcher.

Mr. Witcher pointed out that the Assistant City Manager is the one who normally oversees everything project-wise in the city. Mr. Ward said that a lot of his duties include Public Works projects like the streets, water, wastewater and parks. Mr. Ward shared that the Capital Improvement Committee has a meeting tomorrow, and that the committee tries to have a 5 year window for future projects, and as they come to the top of the list, the city reviews the project to see if it is still in the best interests of the city.

This week Mr. Ward said they will be reviewing the fleet needs of the city. In terms of patrol cars, with the vehicle and electronic

accessories needed, the cost of a police unit is now in the mid \$50,000 range. He also said they are becoming more difficult to find. There are different metrics the city uses to determine when to replace a vehicle, patrol cars as well as other city vehicles; how much maintenance is costing, how many miles are on the vehicle and the age of the vehicle. Since the City of Lampasas is fairly small, the vehicles see less wear and tear than in a big city and usually last longer.

He stated that Lampasas PD Officers, Fire Chiefs, and after hours response personnel for the Public Works Dept. are allowed to take city vehicles home.

Paving season is approaching and some of the roads the city hopes to work on are Western St. from the bridge to 190, Briggs St., Pecan St. between  $2^{nd} \& 3^{rd}$  and the main entrance to Sunrise Hills. The city does not have the equipment to lay down asphalt so those jobs go out for bid. The city does have seal-coating equipment and they try to keep up with working on roads that have cracks in the asphalt.

### **Good News from AAA** on Summer Gas Prices

A story from Scripps news tell us that filling up at the pump this summer might not be as painful as it was in previous years. Usually summers can mean higher gas prices, this year seems different.

Filling up at the pump in recent years has been more of a roller coaster ride than a cruise down the highway. Prices for gas had hit frightening highs in many parts of the United States.

AAA is offering an optimistic forecast on the price you could see at gas stations this summer. You may see prices stay steady at around \$3 in some areas.

Experts say last June the country saw a record high of around \$5.02 a gallon. We could see those prices go down to around \$3.50 by June. AAA says there are even gas stations across the U.S. selling gas at under \$3 a gallon.

Experts say while it might be a good time to do more driving this summer, they have noticed that driver rates stay fairly steady no matter what the gas prices are. AAA says the lower gas prices could continue to be a trend for the foreseeable future. That's good news for commuters and travelers alike.
