The Weather



High yesterday was 70° The low this morning was 44°

Today: Sunny for a change, with a high near 77° and light N-NW wind becoming N-NE 5-10 mph in the morning.

Tonight: Patchy for after 4am, otherwise partly cloudy, with a low around 60° and NE wind 5 mph becoming SE after midnight.

Sunday: Some morning fog, then sunny with a high near 83° and S-SE wind 5-10 mph.

Monday brings a 30% chance of another rain, likely after 1pm in the afternoon, otherwise partly sunny and up to 81° in the afternoon with S-SE wind 5-10 mph.

Tuesday brings a 30% rain chance again, and a humid high of about 84°. The south wind will be light.

Wednesday the odds of rain go to 50% with an 84° high and that holds for Thursday and Friday also.

City and School Elections are going on today in Lampasas, Kempner and Lometa.

You can vote in the general election for City and School Board Elections today.

Regular Election Day polls will be open 7 to 7 on today at the County Election Office or at the Kempner Fire Dept. Training Center Building for the Lampasas and Kempner Elections. For the Lometa Election you can vote only at Lometa City Hall.

Early voting numbers showed a total of 940 total ballots with 574 of those being city of Lampasas ballots.

The Badger Baseball playoff series

was unfortunately taking place in the part of Texas that was getting torrential rain and flooding Thursday and Friday. It was rained out completely on Thursday evening, never even starting, then on Friday players and fans had to be evacuated from the field in the third inning.

The rain turned into a stormy downpour that flooded the town of Dripping Springs, washing cars off the road and flooding downtown businesses. The Lampasas and Boerne crowds had to pretty much run for their life a little after 7pm, fighting a highway with as much as a foot of rushing water in some places, and crowded with emergency vehicles.

As to the ball game, it was in the bottom of the third and Lampasas was behind 1-0 after an earlier Boerne hit had turned into a runner on third and a subsequent batter hit a fly ball into the field that allowed the base runner to tag up and then go home.

Otherwise, it wasn't a bad game to that point. Unfortunately, with UIL rules such as they are, the "series" has now been done away with, and it has turned into a one-game playoff. (more detail in Sports)

This "one game" will start back up this afternoon at 4pm where it left off, and whoever wins it will be the bi-district champion.

The whole thing has been tremendously unfavorable for Lampasas. The team has to fight back against the odds and hardships today, however difficult or unfair, and be the champions we Badger fans know they are.

Badger Baseball



The Badgers and Boerne Greyhounds game was stopped and postponed yesterday evening in Dripping Springs due to torrential rain and wind storms. When it was stopped, Boerne was ahead by 1 run.

Fighting slightly wet artificial turf and occasional rain, the game was attempting to go on. It was hugely important because UIL rules require that any series has to have at least one game completed by Friday night at midnight, otherwise it has to go to a one game playoff on Saturday. The teams were desperately trying to get the required 4 innings in Friday night. But, it didn't happen.

They were in the bottom of the 3rd, with Lampasas at bat, when the rain became too heavy to play and umpires stopped it. Ace Whitehead, the top of the Badger batting order, had come to the plate. Boerne's Cale Mathison was on the mound.

Mathison had thrown 40 pitches in his 2 innings, 22 of them strikes, and had given up 1 hit. He struck out 3 Badger batters and walked 2 of them.

Marty Ybarra had been on the mound for the Badgers for 3 innings, throwing 62 pitches, 37 of them strikes. He had given up 1 hit in those 3 innings, struck out 4 Greyhound batters and walked 2.

At bat, the first batter up for Boerne in the game, Doug Hodo, got a big hit that ended in a run. It was the hit for the Greyhounds and the only score in the game.

For Lampasas, Gauge Gholson got a hit in the bottom of the 1st inning, a line drive single that got by the third basemen and into left field. Previous to Gholson's hit, Ace Whitehead had walked to 1st, so the hit advanced him to 2nd. Next up was Ethan Rascoe, who also got the walk. This loaded the bases and Badger hopes were high, but the next three Badger batters either struck out or flied out.

So-o, the game starts up again this afternoon at 4pm, winner take all, on the artificial turf at Dripping Springs, a town that is still trying to dry itself off this morning.

The crucial ball game will be broadcast live over KACQ 101.9FM, with the broadcast going on air about 3:30pm.

The district playoff games look like this:

#1 Liberty Hill (our Dist 27) will play **#4 Fredericksburg (Dist 28)** at 7pm this evening. Their Friday game was a rainout so they have a 1 game playoff today in Liberty Hill.

#2 Lampasas (Dist 27) will continue with their one game playoff against **#3 Boerne (Dist 28)** at 4pm this afternoon in Dripping Springs.

#3 Salado (Dist 27) lost to **#2 Wimberley (Dist 28)** 7-5 on Thursday, got rained out Friday and go to game 2 today.

#4 Taylor (Dist 27) lost to **#1 Llano (Dist 28)** 15-2 on Thursday. Their second game, scheduled for Friday, was stopped in the bottom of the 6th with Llano ahead 1-0. It went the required 4 innings so we assume it was a loss for Taylor and will not continue.
