I went across the border for a while on a tour bus with a female East German soldier telling us how wonderful life was under communism. It sure didn't look good to me.

I like to remember the years I spent teaching and the young faces of students whose minds I hoped I would affect and help develop, and I like to remember all the friends I made being the local "radio man" in town.

Our memories, our experiences, our adventures, are what define us. Here's hoping that you, whether young or old, will take close note of your adventures. You'll savor them one day. Here's rootin' for ya'.
