**Today:** Look for mostly sunny skies with a high temperature near 94° and a 40% chance of showers and storms this afternoon with some possibly severe along and west of I-35. Wind will be S-SW at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Look for mostly cloudy skies tonight and the low temperature will be near 65°. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms in the evening with some possibly severe. SE wind near 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Saturday:** Look for partly sunny skies and a high temperature near 93° and heat indices as high as 97°. Wind will be S at 10-15 mph and there is a 20% chance of precipitation in the afternoon.

#### The Aquarid Meteor Shower

According to a story by Justin Boggs of Scripps news there are astronomical events are occurring this weekend, including one that can be seen in the U.S.

The Aquariid meteor shower will peak this weekend with an estimated 10-30 meteors shooting across the night sky per hour. According to the American Meteor Society, the shower will peak early Saturday morning. The best time to look, according to the AMS, will be in the pre-dawn hours. The meteors will radiate from the constellation Aquarius, which rises in most areas across the U.S. a couple hours before sunrise. You can look for it in the southeast sky.

The meteor shower is caused by leftover bits from the comet Halley hitting the Earth's atmosphere. Halley was last seen by casual observers in 1986. The comet is expected to reenter the Solar System in 2061, NASA said.

One downside to the timing of this year's Aquariids is it coincides with a full moon, which will dampen some of the vividness of the meteor shower.

The City of Lampasas is having elections for Mayor and City Council Place 2. Lampasas City Council Places 1 and 6 are uncontested. Running for Mayor are Herb Pearce and Cathy Kuehne. Place 2 has Bob Goodart and Eric Hernandez on the ballot.
