The Weather

Rainfall at Lampasas Airport past 24hrs - .47in
Lometa recorded .66in. but Burnet got 1.79 and a bit more SW
at Tow it was 3.24in.

Today: Partly sunny with a high of about 93° and a 20% chance
of another shower or thunderstorm after 4pm. The south breeze
should be about 10mph.

Tonight: The rain chances go up to around 40%, mainly early,
from 7pm to 1am, and the overnight low should be around 67°.
S-SSE wind should be around 10-15 mph.

Sunday: There is a 30% chance of rain in the afternoon, other-
wise mostly cloudy with a high near 88°. The wind should be
S-SE at 10-15 mph. Overnight the rain chances drop to about
20% and the low would be about 67°.

Monday: The high will climb back up to about 89° and there
will still be a 20% chance of rain with the same 10-15 mph south
wind.

What's Up This Weekend?



It's Election Day! City Council, Mayor and School
Board Elections take place today at your chosen
polling place. For the Lampasas and Kempner Elections you can
cast ballots at the Elections Office at 407 S. Pecan in Lampasas
or the Kempner Fire Department Training Center at 315 S. Pecan
in Kempner.

The most interest seems to be in the Mayoral Election in
Lampasas between Councilman Herb Pearce and Council woman
Cathy Kuehne. The Council Place 2 position sees Eric Hernandez
and Bob Goodart vying for the chair. In Kempner, voters are
being asked to vote for or against a ½% city sales tax increase.
For the Lometa Elections where, besides the race for a pair of
school board seats, there is the approval or turn down of a 1.75
million dollar school bond, you can vote at the Lometa City Hall
at 100 San Saba St. in Lometa.

Hours for Election Day voting are 7am to 7pm.
