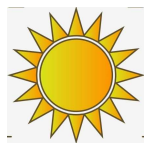

Badger Baseball Heads to Playoffs



Winding up their regular season play in second place in district competition, the Lampasas Badgers are bound for Mineral Wells this afternoon, there to play the Burk Burnett Bulldogs in a bi-district matchup. They'll meet tonight at 7pm, then again Saturday at 11am for game two of the best 2 of 3 series. If they're tied after the Saturday mid-day game, they'll immediately play a game 3.

Coach Chance Evans told Ronnie Witcher on Friday that the Bulldogs are expected to be a good matchup. He says they have more than one good hurler, including two lefties. He also said Badger fans could expect to see Ace Whitehead as the starting pitcher for the Badgers. Putting his Ace pitcher on the mound is Coach's move to try and get game 1 in the bag. Whether or not the Bulldogs will have the same plan remains to be seen.



Badger bats have been working well in the two warmup games they've played over the last several days and if they stay hot, it could be some tough competition for the Bulldogs.

The bi-district series in Mineral Wells will be played on a grass field, but what Coach Evans calls "an oasis," referring to the quality of the field and facilities. "It's a solid playing surface and a good atmosphere for students and fans," he says.

The trip to Mineral Wells is a long one for team and fans - two hours plus - so the team is staying overnight, and many fans may as well. Railroad Track Repairs

Child-Tax-Credit Checks Arriving in July

According to an article in CNET, the IRS will begin sending out payments this summer to some low- and moderate-income families, depending on the age of their children. Starting in July, families will get monthly payments of \$250 to \$300. The payouts will continue through December. The money is part of an increase to the 2021 child tax credit from the American Rescue Plan that passed in March. Previously, the amount was \$2,000 but has been increased to \$3,000. Families with children under the age of 6 will get \$3,600. (The change also allows 17-year-olds to qualify for the first time.) Unlike stimulus checks, the expanded child tax credit will be paid out in two distinct phases. Half your child tax credit total will arrive in monthly checks, beginning in July and continuing through December. The other half will be paid out on your 2021 tax return when you file in 2022. Anyone who qualifies and files a 2020 return by the new May 17 tax deadline will begin receiving monthly checks automatically -- no need to file, claim, request or otherwise hunt down your money, as long as the IRS knows how many dependents you have.

Child Tax

Okay, but how can parents of 2021 babies claim the child tax credit? If your dependents haven't been reported to the IRS by July (or haven't even been born yet), you have two options for receiving your payment. First, you could always wait until you file your return next spring and receive the entire child tax credit in one lump sum, just like how the former version of the credit worked. But if you'd like to receive monthly payments before next year's tax season rolls around, there's another option.

Sarah Tew from CNET reports that the IRS has promised to set up an online portal for taxpayers to report any change in status (dependents, income, etc.) throughout the year. We don't have a lot of information yet about how the *(cont'd on back)*
