Lampasas ISD Teacher Arrested for DWI

From the Lampasas Police Dept: Yesterday, 05/06/22 at approximately 9:27am, the Lampasas Police Dept. was dispatched to the intersection of S. Key Ave. and 6th St. in reference to a 2-vehicle accident. Upon Arrival Officers located a single vehicle that reported to be involved in the said accident. The driver reported to Officers that the second vehicle left the scene before the Officer's arrival. A description of the vehicle and partial license plate was provided to the Officers during the accident investigation. Officers were also told that the driver that left the scene was wearing an LISD identification tag consistent with that of an employee of LISD. Shortly after the initial report, Officers located a vehicle at the LISD Middle School matching the description given. The vehicle did have damage consistent with the reported accident. The owner of the vehicle was contacted by Officers with the cooperation of the LISD Administration. The owner of the vehicle was identified as 57-year old Michael Foreman who is currently employed as a teacher by LISD Middle School. Foreman was interviewed and it was determined that he was the driver of his vehicle during the said accident. It was suspected by Officers that Foreman may have been intoxicated and was subsequently arrested for DWI. Foreman was then taken to Lampasas County Jail. Bond had not been set as of this morning.

The Workshop session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes: the 2nd quarter financial update, discussion regarding Calvery Municipal Building Improvement Project Scope, discussion and presentation of fiscal year 2022 Street Improvement projects, discussion of walking trails combination and options, zoning amendments related to building height, and discussion of the Fire Dept.
