## The Weather

**Tonight:** Partly cloudy with a low near 52°. Winds will be N-NE near 5-15 mph, gusting to 25 mph.


**Saturday:** Mostly Sunny with a high near 76° and N-NE wind at 5-10 mph shifting to the E in the afternoon.

Governor Greg Abbott issued an executive order on May 5<sup>th</sup> that reads in part: "Starting at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, May 8, 2020:

Cosmetology salons, hair salons, barber shops, nail salons/shops, and other establishments where licensed cosmetologists or barbers practice their trade; provided, however, that all such salons, shops, and establishments must ensure at least six feet of social distancing between operating work stations.

Tanning salons; provided, however, that all such salons must ensure at least six feet of social distancing between operating work stations. "

Lampasas Radio reached out to some of our local businesses and found the following: The 1<sup>st</sup> Texas Bank on the square has opened their lobby,

El Rodeo and Medina's will be opening their dining room today. Putters-n-Gutters will be opening up their bowling alley, skating rink and bowling alley at 50% capacity at 4pm today. There will be extra measures taken to ensure cleanliness, social distancing, and sanitary conditions. For a haircut, Great Clips has reopened **only for haircuts**. However, you must either check in online or call, they will tell you the wait time, then they will call you when it is your turn.



The Lampasas Barber shop will be open on Monday. No one answered at Gypsy Sisters or The Fixx Salon.

If you need to get your nails done, you may have to search a little bit. There was no answer at the Nail Spa by Walmart, and the Nanson 2 (by Tractor Supply) is still closed. Angela Nails on 4<sup>th</sup> is open.

More businesses will be allowed to open on May 18<sup>th</sup> according to the executive order:

"Starting at 12:01 a.m. on Monday, May 18, 2020:

- Services provided by office workers in offices that operate at up to the greater of (i) five individuals, or (ii) 25 percent of the total office workforce; provided, however, that the individuals maintain appropriate social distancing.
- Manufacturing services, for facilities that operate at up to 25 percent of the total listed occupancy of the facility.
- Gyms and exercise facilities and classes that operate at up to 25 percent of the total listed occupancy of the gym or exercise facility; provided, however, that locker rooms and shower facilities must remain closed, but restrooms may open

## Update From Local Medical Authority



Dr. Georgia Hay came in for her weekly visit at the Lampasas Studios this morning. She relayed a lot of information in a very short time.

Lampasas County now has 6 active COVID-19 cases, with another confirmed yesterday evening being a female in her 50's. Of the 8 cases in Lampasas 5 of them have been female.

Dr. Hay stated that the spread of the virus was inevitable, and that it was expected that the spread, and therefore the peak would be behind the larger cities. The neighboring counties showing increasing cases is also an indicator that our case count will be rising, and she thinks the case count will be rising for a few weeks at a minimum.

A lot of residents are concerned about contact tracing for the confirmed cases. When Governor Abbott began planning to reopen Texas, he knew there would be more cases. Part of the plan is to hire more people at the Public Health Regional Offices specifically for contact tracing, to be aggressive in pursuing this. The issue about releasing locations is a privacy issue, says Dr. Hay.

"Knowing where they live does not make you any safer" she stated. There is COVID-19 in every city in the county. The contacts are contacted by Public Health Region 7, and Dr. Hay assists. Contract tracing has shown positive cases, and yes, all the local health authorities know this. If you have COVID-19 and don't know where you got it, it was community spread.

If you are a household contact of someone who has a confirmed case, quarantine for 14 days!!! Even if you test negative before the 14 days is up. 95% of the cases show within 5 days. Some cases have taken as long as 14 days to show. If you take the test before the 14 days is up, it may be a false negative. Test results from the larger labs are coming back in 48-72 hours generally; the state tests are taking a week.
