### **Saturday's Election Results**

In the Lampasas/Kempner Joint Election Saturday, a total of 628 ballots were cast.

In the City of Kempner, residents voted to increase the local sales tax dedicated to the maintenance and repair of municipal streets from 0.25% to 0.50%. This proposition passed with 18 votes for and 16 votes against.

.The new Mayor for the City of Lampasas is Herb Pearce who garnered 307 votes to Cathy Kuehne's 105 votes. The City Council Place 2 race went to Eric Hernandez with 252 votes to Bob Goodart's 146 votes.

In the Lometa ISD the School Bond Election, Proposition A passed with 149 votes for and 30 votes against. Courtney Duncan and Mario Maldonado will fill the 2 at-large place on the Lometa ISD School Board, and Jarlyn Downey, Alex Witherspoon and Luella 'Ronnie' Cartwright are the new city council members.

### **Commissioners Court**

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met this morning at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda included the consent agenda, to include monthly reports from county offices, accounts payable and payroll, A subdivision Plat Approval Agreement within ETJ of City of Lampasas and Lampasas County, appointment of a sub-committee of Commissioners Court to meet and plan with the Hill Country Transit District on budget talks, approval of a Texas A & M Forest Service Grant for Lometa VFD in the amount of \$90,000 for purchase of a large truck chassis, award of a bid for no spec/spec flex base and requested records management funds for case management and scanning for the County Clerk's Office.

### Lampasas City Council

The Lampasas City Council will meet this afternoon for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the City Council will meet in Executive Session to discuss rate hikes for customers for water and electric and to discuss a business prospect with which the city is conducting economic development negotiations, and to deliberate financial and other incentives for this business.

The Workshop session will then be re-convened. The agenda for the workshop session includes discussion and possible action concerning items from the executive session, updates on the solar eclipse event, substandard structures, the Chamber of Commerce Bi-Annual Report, teh HOP-Rural transit system and the FY 2024 budget.

The Regular Session will begin immediately following the Workshop Session (possibly prior to 6pm), and will see the proclamations of National Police Week May 14-20 and National Public Works Week May 21-27. (cont'd on back)
