The Weather

High yesterday was 81° The low this morning was 50°

The official rainfall at the airport Thursday - .1 in.

Total rainfall at the airport gauge this month - 2.33 in.

Total rainfall at the airport gauge in April - 1.84 in.

Today: A 30% rain chance, mainly after 11am, then cloudy with a high near 63° and certainly cool with a north wind of 10-15 mph and gusting to 20.

Tonight: A 70% rain chance and very cool with a low of 53° predicted. The N-NE wind should be light.

Saturday: A 70% rain chance, probably early, and still cloudy. The high may make it up to 70° with light north wind. Overnight it will be cloudy, a very small chance of rain, and the temperature down to 53°.

Sunday morning will bring nice sunshine and a temperature that rises into the mid 70s, still with a north wind until late. By Monday morning the wind may shift to the east.

Next week we expect the wind to shift back to east and then south but the rain chances are expected to creep back in to some degree.

The weather forecasters seemed to predict a mid-afternoon window where they thought it wouldn't be raining at Hutto, the game site. So, in order to try and get in at least one of the two planned games for the day, the agreement was made to move the 1st pitch time up from 5pm to 2pm.

The earlier start will be a bit inconvenient for the team and certainly the fans, but if the change works, it is certainly better than a rainout, which is what happened to the Badgers last week at Dripping Springs. Go Badgers!

The Commissioners will meet at 9am in the courthouse with an agenda item listed as "Petition for creation of Emergency Services District – Dan Hause." This discussion, if acted on, is on a petition that would bring about an election to create a new taxing entity in the county. It would create an ESD that would have the right to levy an additional property tax on homes and business in the District. Other items on that Commissioner's agenda include the resignation of County Tax Assessor Linda Crawford, the sale or transfer of some surplus property, some subdivision matters, and some fairly minor budget matters.

Lampasas City Council will meet at 5:30pm in a workshop session and regular session at 7pm.
