The Weather

Today: Look for partly sunny skies with a 30% chance of precipitation and a high temperature near 82°. There will be a light E wind near 5 mph.

Tonight: Increasingly cloudy skies and the low temperature will dip to near 68°. Wind will be E near 10 mph.

In Lampasas Radio Studios

Jody Cummings Chief of Police for the Lampasas Police Department, was in Lampasas Radio Studios this morning for a visit with Angel Garcia and Ronnie Witcher.

Chief Cummings shared that all patrol units now carry Norcan, an opioid antagonist that can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose, including fentanyl. The Police Chief said that while we have the Norcan on hand, so far the Lampasas Police Department has not had to use the Norcan. The local law enforcement, he said, has not seen any fentanyl in our immediate area. The Police Chief calls us an 'island community', that we are not tied to any large cities, which lessens the chances of seeing the same problems as large cities.

When asked about weapons in town, Chief Cummings stated that weapons have been a historical part of our culture. While they see weapons as part of arrests or other law enforcement activity, they haven't seen anything too advanced. The gun laws are constantly changing so all law enforcement has to stay aware of new laws, and to be prepared to protect our community.

He also shared that the local police departments have nothing to do with background checks, that those have to be done through a retail establishment.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on May 5th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 23 cases were brought to the court with 16 cases involving men and 7 cases involving women. Paul Spensser failed to appear on the charge of theft of property \$2500-\$30,000. Oshaun Robinson of Killeen failed to appear on the charge of evading arrest/detention w/ a vehicle.

There were 9 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 3 cases for possession less than a gram. There were 5 cases for possession of 1-4 grams. There was 1 case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1/less than 400 grams.

There were 5 cases for evading arrest, 2 burglary cases, and 1 case each for forgery, theft and tampering with evidence.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was 1 case for assault of a family member.

In other cases there were 2 cases of indecency with a child/sexual contact, and one case of sexual assault of a child. *(cont'd on back)*

Michael Hernandez of Eden, Texas plead guilty to evading arrest with a vehicle and was sentenced to 8 years TDCJ with credit for time served. On the charge of evading arrest with a vehicle, Jeremy Casey of Lampasas was sentenced to 4 years probation. Melinda Downey of Bertram on the charge of evading arrest with a vehicle, saw her probation adjudicated and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ with credit for time served. Devion Davis, of Temple was sentenced to 5 years of probation on the charge of manufacture /delivery of a controlled substance PG1 less than 400 grams.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.

"Athena Alert Bill" passes Texas House

The Texas House passed the "Athena Alert" bill or HB3556 yesterday, allowing law enforcement to quickly issue a regional alert when a child goes missing without confirmation of an abduction.

The legislation – named in memory of 7-year-old Athena Strand who was kidnapped and killed by former FedEx driver Tanner Lynn Horner last year – is intended to close the gap between the time a child vanishes and a statewide AMBER Alert may be issued. It would allow law enforcement to activate an alert in a regional area – within a 100-mile radius and to adjacent counties – of where a child is believed to have gone missing or was last seen.

Authored by Rep. Lynn Stucky (R-Sanger), the bill now heads to the Senate. It will be carried by Senators Tan Parker (R-Flower Mound) and Angela Paxton (R-McKinney) in the next chamber. If passed there, it will make its way to Texas Governor Greg Abbott's desk.

"I would like to thank Rep. Stucky and other lawmakers for their support of an Athena Alert in honor of my daughter," said Maitlyn Gandy, Athena's mother. An Athena Alert gives law enforcement the ability to quickly notify the local public about a missing child in their area – even if the case doesn't meet the strict criteria for a statewide AMBER Alert.

She previously filed an 18-page wrongful death lawsuit in February seeking "fair and reasonable" compensation for "acts and omissions" that led to Strand's murder. Tanner, and the contracting company that hired him, Big Topspin, were named in the suit. Horner was charged with capital murder and aggravated kidnapping. If convicted, he faces the death penalty.
