Monday meetings

MEETING!! The Commissioners will meet at 9am in the courthouse with an agenda item listed as "Petition for creation of Emergency Services District – Dan Hause." This discussion, if acted on, is on a petition that would bring about an election to create a new taxing entity in the county. It would create an ESD that would have the right to levy an additional property tax on homes and business in the District. Other items on that Commissioner's agenda include the resignation of County Tax Assessor Linda Crawford, the sale or transfer of some surplus property, some subdivision matters, and some fairly minor budget matters.

Lampasas City Council will meet at 5:30pm in a workshop session and regular session at 7pm. On the agenda for the special session is accepting the votes for the special election held on May 4th, presentation to outgoing city council member, and



administering the Oath of Office to newly Elected Council Members. In the special session, there will be discussion and possible action concerning the appointment of Mayor Pro Tem for the 2019-2020 term and the reappointment of the Municipal Court Judge.

New business in the regular session includes discussion and/or modification of the preliminary plat for Brodie Estates, discussion of the Stone Valley Development Agreement, and work on the parking lot behind city hall. Discussion concerning a possible agreement between Eckermann Engineering for water and wastewater line work, and the water conservation and drought contingency plan.

Also, The Lampasas City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7pm in the Council Chambers to receive input regarding adoption of the 2019-2023 Drought Contingency and Water Conservation Plan.

Lometa's School Board meets at 6:30pm in their school library.
