District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on May 6th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 44 cases were brought to the court with 34 cases involving men, and 10 cases involving women.

There were 17 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 8 cases for less than a gram, 5 cases for 1-4 grams and 4 cases for 4-200 grams. There were 3 cases for possession of a controlled substance PG 2 less than a gram. There were 2 DWI cases.

There were 5 burglary cases, and 2 cases each for tampering with evidence and engaging in organized criminal activity. There was one case each for fraud, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, interference w/child custody, evading arrest and FTA/bail jumping.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 2 cases of assault of a family member, and one case each for invasive visual recording, accident involving injury, intoxication manslaughter, indecency with a child/sexual contact, failure to comply as a registered sex offender, and aggravated sexual assault of a child.

Of the 44 cases, 10 were resolved with Clarence Bidy pleading

guilty to tampering with evidence, and possession of a controlled substance PG1, 1-4 grams and was sentenced to 4 years TDCJ on each count plus court costs. On the charge of invasive visual recording, Joshua Delacruz plead guilty and was sentenced to 5 years of probation plus a fine and court costs. Angel Gauna plead guilty to burglary of a habitation and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ with credit for days served plus court costs. Jamichael Moore, of Copperas Cove plead guilty for evading arrest w/ vehicle and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ with days served credited towards sentence plus court costs. David Delgado saw his probation extended w/stipulation of attending a SAFFP for possession of a controlled substance PG 1, 1-4 grams. Joe Garza was sentenced to 4 years TDCJ w/credit for days served plus court costs for tampering w/intent to impair physical evidence. Camry Brown on the charge of bail jumping and FTA felony, was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ w/ credit for days served plus court costs, and on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram Ms. Brown was sentenced to 12 months in State Jail w/ credit for days served. David Parks, on the charge of DWI 3rd or more was sentenced to 12 years TDCJ w/ credit for days served plus court costs.

All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials.
