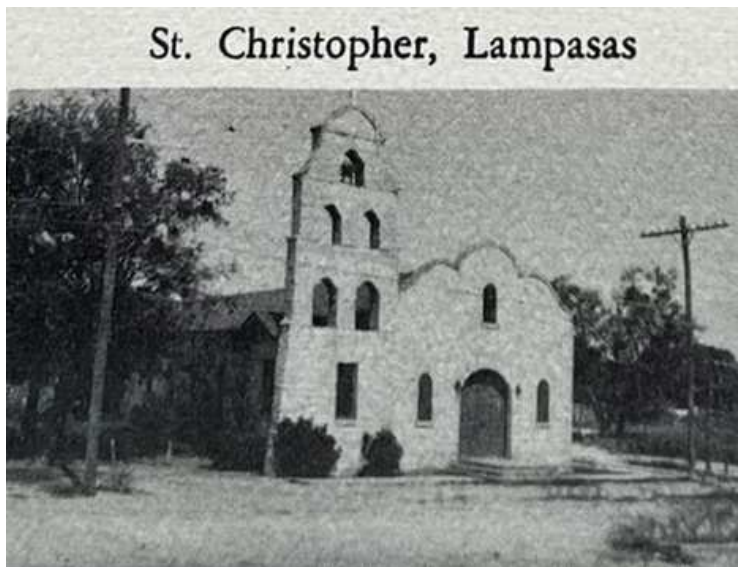
Update on the 4th Street Church

From the Lampasas Heritage Foundation:

"I know it's taken a LONG time to get some movement on the 4th Street Church, but not only do we have an architect (Jennifer Walker) and an engineer diligently working on plans, but Boyce Cabiness has located a photo (*above right*) of the church as it looked when it was built. He has been in contact with families who attended and were even married in St. Christopher as well as extensive research into its origins. Applications have been made which will open the opportunity for grants to assist in the reconstruction.

Engineering work centers on building a steel skeleton inside the walls and bolting the walls to the skeleton which will provide the structural support necessary to support the walls and the roof."

The church had several different names, but the original name was Saint Christopher Catholic Church. It later became a Methodist church. The Lampasas Heritage Foundation will be having functions that will benefit the restoration of the St. Christopher Church as well as other projects in the future.



And to raise awareness of the rich history of Lampasas, the Lampasas Heritage Foundation will also present "Rockin' Rides and Smokin' Swing" on Spring Ho Sunday from noon until 4pm. The event will be at the Lampasas Courthouse Square, have cars from all eras, and the Hot Texas Swing Band. Free to attend!

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced yesterday he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.2 Billion dollars in local sales tax allocations for May. That is up 4.3% from last year. These allocations are based on sales made in March by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate increase 11.26% over the same period last year, with a \$6572.15 rebate.

The City of Hamilton saw a 2.03% increase over the same month last year in their rebate check of \$88,462.09.

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is up 8.7% in their check of \$281,557.15. Lometa shows a decrease of 12.43% from last year with a rebate check for \$9059.86 and Kempner received a rebate for \$15,630.50, a 21.94% increase from last year.
