The Weather

Rainfall at the airport so far this month – 2.36 in. Rainfall at LCRA gauge 10 mi. W-SW of town – 4in Rainfall at Lometa LCRA gauge this month – 2.7 in. Rainfall at Colorado River at Bend in May – 3.51in.

Today: Mostly sunny with a high near 79° and light wind becoming E-SE at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: A 20% chance of rain after 4am, mostly cloudy, and a low around 61° with light E-SE wind.

Tuesday: The 20% rain chance continues, along with a little sunshine and a high of 81°. SW wind will be 5-10 mph becoming E-SE in the afternoon.

Overnight rain chances go away with a low of 61°.

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept blotter for Saturday shows the early morning arrest of a 60 year old Lampasas man for DWI at 2am in the 1100 block of S. Key. Also in the 2am hour a prowler was reported in the 200 block of N. Park St. at 2:14am. Sharon Key Riewe, 69, of Goldthwaite was detained in the 300 block of 4th St at 7:15am for a Mills County Warrant for 13 counts of injury to a child. There was burglary of a building reported in the 600 block of N. Broad at 8:57am. The afternoon saw a suspicious person in the 900 block of E. 4th St. at 3:34pm, then reckless drivers in the 400 block of e. 4th St. at 3:55pm and the 300 block of CTE at 9:09pm. AT 10:38pm a 41 year old Copperas Cove resident was arrested in the 500 block of E. 4th St. for DWI.

Sunday's blotter shows a criminal trespass in the 600 block of Hetherly at 1:53am, then a disturbance in the 200 block of W. 2nd at 4:18am. Sunday evening shows burglary of a building in the 600 block of N. Broad at 6:30pm, then a suspicious vehicle in the 800 block of W. 5th St. at 9pm. A 50 year old homeless man was brought in from the 900 block of S. Key at 10:29pm for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone at 10:29pm. A prowler was reported in the 100 block of E. 1st St. at 10:35pm.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. Over the weekend, Lometa responded to a civil matter and an animal complaint. Kempner tended to an accident, a fight in progress, a noise complaint and investigated a suspicious person. Out in the county deputies worked a few civil matters, an animal complaint, and served a warrant. The Sheriff's department went out to Cove on a couple of shots fired calls and a livestock issue.

The jail log shows the county booked in a 44 year old Lampasas man for possession of a controlled substance and a failure to appear charge as well as a 30 year old Copperas Cove woman for possession of marijuana less than 2 oz. Three Killeen men, 19 year old Bryan Chavez, 41 year old Noel Guerrero, and 41 year old Jose Chavez Gutierrez were all booked into the Lampasas County Jail on the afternoon of May 12th for deadly conduct/discharging a firearm. Gutierrez was also put on an ICE detainer.

Lampasas County Commissioners were to be in session this morning at 9am in the courthouse. The big item there expected to be the possibility of an election to set up a new property taxing entity in the county.

Lampasas City Council will be in session at 5:30pm for a workshop and 7pm for a regular session. On their agenda will be swearing in of new Council members. Actually, the only "new" member of the Council will be Randy Clark, the long time, now

retired, Director of Public Works for the City. The Mayor Pro-Tem will also be selected.

Agenda items also include an agreement with the developer of the Stone Valley Subdivision off Nix Road, bids from Canales-Dibble Contractors on concrete work on the City Hall parking lot, agreements with Engineer Derrek Eckermann for water line and wastewater lines, the formation of a Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee, and several grant applications.

Lometa's School Board meets at 6:30pm in their school library.
