He worked for the Colorado River Authority(LCRA) and retired in 2002 after 31 years as a Hydro Production Operator. He initially worked for Houston Power & Light in Houston, Texas.

His father was John David Mitchell and his mother was Johnnie Helen Watson. And he was preceded in death by his parents, and by his son Donald Dale Mitchell, his sister Janet Nell Schultz of Mesquite, Texas and his brother John David Mitchell Jr., of Portland, Oregon.

He is survived in addition to his wife, Joanne P. He was an avid hunter in his early years and a lifelong fisherman of saltwater and freshwater variety. He lived as simply as he could. And in his life, he made eye contact was a bald eagle right here in Lampasas. A phenomenally majestic creature was hunting for prey below the power and telephone lines in our alley. It flew the entire length of our alley, passing Don in midflight before it gained altitude, turned north, then west and flew over the field parallel to the alley. And finally, during his employment, he was part of a team of selected LCRA employees, the hydro production operators, he managed water resources, prevented floods and power outages in Central Texas for millions of Texans along the Colorado River extending the eight hundred miles to Matagorda Bay in the Gulf of Mexico.
