# The Weather

Yesterday's high 87° This morning's low 62°

The airport received 1.2 inches of rain overnight

Lampasas County is under a Flash Flood Watch until Sunday at 7pm.

**Today**: Skies will be cloudy with a high temperature near 77° and an 80% chance of rain, some heavy. Winds will be from the E-SE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a low near 65° and a 70% chance of showers and storms. Wind will be from the SE at 10 mph.

Sunday: The high temperature will climb to near 79° with an 80% chance of precipitation with some possibly heavy. Winds will be S -SE at 5-10 mph.

Sunday Night: Overnight it gets down to 65° with a 40% chance of showers and storms and the wind will be E at 5-10 mph.

Monday: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a high temperature near 80°. The wind will be E near 5-10 mph. There is a 40% chance of precipitation.

Monday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low around 64°. Wind will be E-SE at 5 mph and there is a 30% chance of showers and storms.





# **The Blotter**

# **Texas Senate Bill 8**

### (The Texas School Voucher Program)

The Texas House Education Committee this week postponed voting on Senate Bill 8, which would create an expensive education savings account (ESA) voucher program that would hurt our public schools. But now, the committee has set a meeting for Monday, May 15, and public testimony is not being allowed.

This bill is bad for Texas students and parents:

\* It would cost Texas big time. This bill would create an education savings account program that would give between \$7,500 and \$10,500 in state tax money to subsidize private school tuition for individuals receiving special education services, who are educationally disadvantaged, or who are attending public schools and have 504s, are in D- or F-rated campuses, or have siblings in the ESA program. That could be more than 75% of students in Texas.

\*The bill requires more state tests. Proponents say that it eliminates STAAR, but in truth, it adds two tests every year for each grade in grades 3-8 and increases high school exams from five to six.

\*The bill gives the education commissioner more control and removes all State Board of Education involvement in the state assessment program.

# **Meteorite Lands in Home in New Jersev**

Earlier this week, police in New Jersey reported that an object suspected to be a meteorite crashed through the ceiling of a home, landing on a hardwood floor in the kitchen.

A story from Scripps news tells us that after analysis by researchers in New Jersey, it has been determined to be an actual meteorite. The College of New Jersey joined other researchers in making the determination.

Nathan Magee, chair of the school's physics department, told the Associated Press."We are excited to be able to confirm that the object is a true chondrite meteorite, in excellent condition, and one of a very small number of similar witnessed chondrite falls known to science."

According to the Natural History Museum in the U.K., these types of meteorites are up to about 4.5 billion years old and are leftovers from the formation of the Solar System. The Natural History Museum said these rocks are made out of droplets of silicate minerals mixed with small grains of sulphides and iron-nickel metal.
