## The Weather

## Commissioners Receive Petition to Create ESD



Lampasas Commissioner's Court got official notice that a petition has been circulated by the Kempner Volunteer Fire Department and has received 160 signatures that call for the formation of a new taxing entity in Lampasas County. This entity, encompassing a proposed ESD around the Kempner area, would place a new property tax on those property owners in that district. The tax, according to the proposal explained by Fire Chief Dan Hause, would begin at about 10¢ per hundred dollars of property appraisal. A home that has a \$100,000 appraisal would be taxed \$100, on top of the property tax levied by the city, school and county.

Hause said that he and the other Fire Chiefs in the county looked at the county map to discuss possible ESDs and decided that the

County might need 4 ESDs. One for the Adamsville VFD, one for the Lometa VFD, and one for the Lampasas VFD. The other Fire Chiefs, he said, had decided they would wait to see how the Kempner proposal was accepted by voters before they tried it.

Hause said the Kempner VFD response area covers about 8,000 people, roughly a third of the County population, and that they need to increase the level of fire and emergency protection with better equipment and some paid firemen.

There will be a public hearing on Tuesday, July 16<sup>th</sup> at 6pm, either at Taylor Creek Elementary Cafeteria or in the District Court Room in the Courthouse. An Election for the voters of the proposed ESD would likely take place on Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July.

In another area, the Court discussed, and agreed, to increase the jail fee that the City of Lampasas and other Cities and Counties are paying for people charged with class c misdemeanors. The fee for inmates housed in Lampasas' jail will go from \$25.74 to \$40 dollars per day. This change will take place July 1<sup>st</sup>.

It was also agreed for the Sheriff's Office to purchase a new livestock trailer for the Animal Control Dept. for some \$59,748. The Sheriff said the old trailer was given to them 20 yrs ago and is no longer safe for animals that are in poor condition. The new trailer would be bought from LDJ Sales of Lampasas. Commissioner Bobby Carroll was opposed to the purchase.

Linda Crawford, the long time Tax Assessor/Collector, has opted to resign and her registration was accepted. She has served for 20 years and is going to take time to focus on her life and family.

Judge Randy Hoyer proclaims May 22<sup>nd</sup> as National Poppy Day and asks everyone to wear a Poppy on that day to help recognize veterans.

The preliminary plat for phase 2 of the Lampasas River Place subdivision was accepted. Tad Davis, the owner was there with Tracie Torres to talk about the progress on the subdivision.

**The Lampasas City Council** met last night. In the special session, the canvassed votes from the special election were accepted, and TJ Monroe was selected as Mayor Pro-Tem.

In the workshop session, there was discussion of noise complaints were discussed, and comments were taken from citizens. However, it was found that the noise levels do not violate the current noise ordinance.

In regular session the Council moved to accept the Brodie Estates Plat. No action was taken on the proposals from Canales-Dibble Construction and Eckermann Engineering.

The next meeting has been moved to May 28<sup>th</sup> due to the Memorial Day Holiday.

High. Both were popular, stellar students and athletes. The two were close friends and after graduation they had went into the western mountains of the U.S. to work for the United States Forest Service as smoke jumpers. While there, they were recruited by the CIA.

In that work, even their parents didn't know of their employment or clandestine activities.

The two later found themselves working as parachute drop officers for Air America, a CIA front, in Tibet and Laos. John was also involved in the Bay of Pigs assault in Cuba in 1961.

On August 31, 1961, Darrell and John were killed in a plane crash while attempting to resupply the anti-communist Hmong Army in Northern Laos. Their service to the country was kept secret until recently. In 2017, the two Lampasas heroes were honored at the CIA headquarters in Langley, VA where then CIA Director Mike Pompeo dedicated stars for each on the CIA's Wall of Honor. Since the founding of the CIA in 1947, only 129 have been so honored.

A bronze plaque, placed on a monument honoring the two, will be dedicated at 10am on Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> at Oak Hill Cemetery. It will be at a site just west of the Veteran's Memorial Monument.

The American Legion Post 277, friends and family are invited to participate in an 8am decoration of graves of veterans, as well as the dedication of the Eubanks/Lewis Memorial. There will also be a Memorial Day Weekend Ceremony at Oak Hill on Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup> at 9am.
