North to Alaska....Again

Lampasas retired Ag Teacher Dr. Steve Forsythe, and LHS graduate and Texas A&M University Ag Business major Dawson Raub will join Alaska AgScience Teacher Scott Faulkner in an upcoming "Camp Meetin" in North Pole, Alaska.

The trio will be putting on the 2022 Silent Springs Alaska FFA Chapter Development Camp, May 31-June 3rd at Camp Li-Wa. Forsythe, Raub, and Faulkner have developed a schedule that combines Leadership Principles/ Training along with Community Service of benefit to The North Pole- Fairbanks area.

The theme for Camp is "Invigorate" and Dr. Forsythe will also be the Keynote Speaker at the annual Silent Springs FFA Awards Banquet on May 30th.

One of the projected Community Service Projects on May 31st will be a waterway canvassing by Canoe, of the Chino Lakes area with the area Fisheries, Soil and Water Conservation District. The purpose is to identify location and buildup of the Invasive weed, Elodia. Elodia is a banned plant on all Alaska waters. Another possibility for Camp participants may include macroinvertebrate collections at Bathing Beauty lake to determine the aquatic health for local fish populations.

Dr. Forsythe and Raub (below right) were asked to participate in the 2022 FFA Chapter Development/ Training Camp by the Silent Springs FFA back in January, who voted to take care of all the Lampasans travel Expenses to and from Alaska.

Additional Camp Field trips are planned that include a tour on Tuesday May 31 of the Ruth Burnette Sport Fish Hatchery and on Wednesday, June 1 - a tour of natural Permafrost Tunnels that are unique to Alaska.

Ercot asking Residents to Conserve Electric

A story in the Texas Tribune tells us that after six power plants went down unexpectedly Friday — and with hot weather expected across Texas this weekend — the Electric Reliability Council of Texas on Friday evening is asking consumers to conserve electricity through Sunday.

Texans are asked to set their thermostats to 78 degrees or above between 3 p.m. and 8 p.m. this weekend and to avoid using large appliances at home during those same times.

A spokesperson for ERCOT, which operates the state's main power grid, told The Texas Tribune he does not expect there to be electricity blackouts this weekend.

ERCOT did not say why the plants unexpectedly tripped offline. All reserve power was operating to support the grid, the agency said. The power plant failures led to a loss of about 2,900 megawatts of electricity, which is enough to power more than 580,000 homes.

Power grids must keep supply and demand in balance at all times. When Texas' grid falls below its safety margin of excess supply, the grid operator starts taking additional precautions to avoid blackouts. The first precaution is to ask the public to cut back electricity usage.

April and May are referred to as "shoulder months" in the energy world. That's the time of year when power plants go offline in order to conduct necessary maintenance and other repairs before the hot summer months

ERCOT, however, has recently told multiple power generation companies to delay maintenance on their equipment so the grid could keep up with the hotter-than-usual temperatures recently, which in turn leads to elevated demand for power when Texans crank their air conditioners.

Friday's power plant outages were unrelated to the recent maintenance delays, an ERCOT spokesperson said.
