The Weather

Today: Partly sunny and nice until early afternoon when a 20% chance of rain shows up. The south wind will be light with a high around 81°.

Tonight: Partly cloudy, a low of 63°, and SE wind 5-10.

Thursday: The sun reins again, with a high of 82° in the afternoon and S-SE wind 5-10 mph.

Overnight the sky will be partly cloudy with a low around 66° and S-SE wind 10 mph.

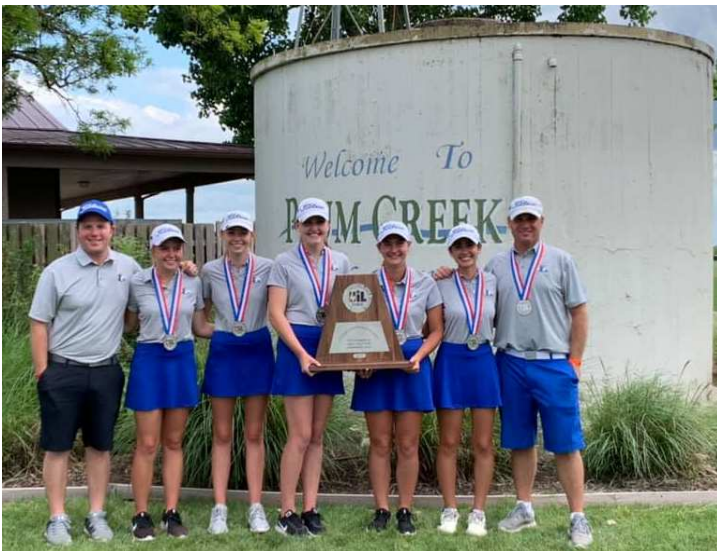
Rest of the week: Friday will be much like Thursday with a high around 83°, but things will change in the overnight as a 40% chance of rain comes along in the wee hours of Saturday morning.

The Saturday forecast may get rough with a 60% chance of a thunderstorm or two. The south wind will blow around 15 mph with gusts.

Overnight Saturday the rain chance drops to 40% but most of that will be gone by Sunday morning.

Sunday's high will be about 87° with only slight rain chances, though the afternoon and evening will be quite warm.

District Court Notes

Lampasas Courthouse was the site of Judge John Gauntt's 27th District Court Docket Call on May 10th.

Altogether 37 cases were on the docket, 6 involved women and 31 involved men. Rudolph Garza charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance PG1 less than a gram failed to appear and a warrant was issued. There were two cases that involved bail jumping on a felony warrant.

There were 16 cases for possession of a controlled substance, 10 of them for less than a gram, 4 cases for 1-4 grams and 2 for over 4 but less than 200 grams. There was one DWI case with a child under 15 in the car.

Felony cases for burglary and theft totaled 5 with one for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and one each for theft of a controlled substance less than \$150,000, theft of a firearm, theft \$1500-\$20,000 and burglary of a habitation. There was a fraud case where Jose Gerardo Chaples-Bruzon of Las Vegas was sentenced to 5 years deferred adjudicated probation plus costs & fees and there was one case for criminal nonsupport.

There were 5 assault cases, two for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, one for assault on a public servant, an assault causing bodily injury to a family member and one for aggravated assault of a household member with a weapon. There were three sex cases, with Martin Gonzales-Cano having his order to dismiss granted on his sexual assault case. On the charge of aggravated sexual assault of a child, Elvis Smith of Milano was sentenced to 5 years deferred adjudicated probation plus costs & fees (cont'd on back)
