## The Weather

**The High yesterday 79° The Morning Low 65°**

**Today:** Cloudy, with a high near 80° and S wind around 5-15 mph and gusting to 20. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms this afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy with a 50% chance of showers and storms. The low temperature will be near 66° overnight. The S-SE wind will be near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.
