Early Voting Begins in May Runoff Election

Texas will hold its 2022 runoff elections May 24 to finalize which Democratic and Republican primary candidates will be on the ballot in the November general election. Early voting begins today, and will be from 8am-5pm Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and 7am to 7pm on Tuesday for this week. The deadline for mail-in ballots to be returned to the county is election day, which is May 24. If they're postmarked by 7 p.m. that day, they'll be counted if they're received by the county by 5 p.m. May 25.

In 50 races in the March 1 primary, no candidate exceeded 50% of the vote, bringing about runoff races between the candidates who came in first and second. The winner will face the other major party nominee in that race, as well as possible Libertarian and Green party candidates. Independent and write-in candidates have until the summer to file their candidacies.

In our area, there will be a runoff election for the District 24 Senate seat and the runoff is between Raul Reyes and Pete Flores. There will also be a runoff between Dianne Miller and Dee Ann Crawford for the County Clerk Office.

The statewide runoffs for democrats are as follows: Attorney General, Rochelle Garza vs. Joe Jaworski; Lt. Governor, Michelle Beckley vs. Mike Collier; Land Commissioner, Jay Kleberg vs. Sandragrace Martinez; State Comptroller Janet Dudding vs. Angel Luis Vega.

The statewide runoffs for Republicans are as follows; Attorney General, George P. Bush vs. Ken Paxton; Land Commissioner, Dawn Buckingham vs. Tim Westley and Railroad Commissioner, Wayne Christian vs. Sarah Stogner.

Baby Formula Shortage

For months, U.S. parents and caregivers have been contending with low supplies of baby formula. But in recent weeks, the products have been especially hard to find, forcing some retailers to limit purchases as the Food and Drug Administration scrambles to respond to the crisis.

Roughly 1 in 4 parents exclusively breastfeed their children up to the age of 6 months, according to the national Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, leaving the overwhelming majority of parents and caregivers at least partially dependent on formula.

The shortage “has been compounded by supply chain challenges, product recalls and historic inflation,” said Ben Reich, chief executive of Datasembly, which tracks retail information. As of last week, formula stockpiles were 43 percent lower than normal, data show, compared with 30 to 40 percent readings last month.

Ongoing supply chain disruptions tied to the coronavirus pandemic have fueled shortages of a wide range of consumer goods, but the lack of baby formula worsened in February after manufacturer Abbott issued a recall for products made at a Michigan plant and sold under the Similac, Alimentum and EleCare labels. Four children — one in Minnesota, one in Texas and two in Ohio — fell ill with bacterial infections, and two died.

The FDA said the bacterium *Cronobacter sakazakii* “may have contributed to the cause of death for both patients.”

Abbott said its own investigation concluded that the infant formula made at its Sturgis, Mich., facility is unlikely to be the source of the infections. On Wednesday, Abbott said it could restart production at the facility in two weeks, with clearance from the FDA, Reuters reported. It will take six to eight weeks for product to hit shelves once production comes back online, Abbott said.

Health regulators recently announced several steps designed to boost supply, including allowing faster importation of formula made overseas. Typically, 98% of baby formula consumed in the U.S. is made domestically, according to federal officials.

Locally WalMart has a limit of 5 formula products per customer, and HEB has a limit of 4 per customer, and HEB stated they are receiving very limited supplies.
