

New Texas Electric Vehicle Registration Rates

On Saturday, Gov. Greg Abbott signed an electric vehicle tax into law. Senate Bill 505 requires electric vehicle owners to pay \$400 to register a new electric vehicle, on top of other fees. Renewing registration will cost \$200. The new tax does not apply to electric motorcycles, mopeds or autocycles.

The fee is intended to ensure that electric vehicle owners pay their fare share toward highway costs, which are usually covered by a 20 cent-per-gallon gas tax paid by owners of gas-fueled and hybrid vehicles.

The average owner of a gas-fueled vehicle pays approximately \$130 in state gas taxes per year according to reports. Both that tax and the new electric vehicle tax are dedicated to the state highway fund, though some revenue is also diverted to schools, according to the report.

It is reported that the new electric vehicle tax will funnel at least \$38 million in new money to the state highway fund, while gas and diesel taxes will generate an estimated \$3.8 billion in revenue for Texas in 2024.

The new electric vehicle tax goes into effect on Sept. 1.

According to a story at kxan.com, a Michigan girl was able to escape an attempted kidnapping when her brother used a slingshot to strike the would-be attacker, authorities said this week.

The 17-year-old's name has not been released though he has been charged as an adult with one count of attempted kidnapping/child enticement, one count of attempted assault to do great bodily harm less than murder, and one count of assault and battery.

Michigan State Police said in a news release that the 8-year-old girl was in her backyard when the alleged assailant came out of the woods, grabbed her and covered her mouth. Authorities said the girl's brother, 13, hit the alleged attacker in the head and chest using a slingshot.

Police later arrested the 17-year-old based on another family member's description of the suspect. Authorities also said the teenager had visible wounds from the slingshot.
