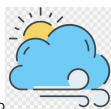

The Weather



High yesterday was 84° The low this morning was 67°

Today: Another nice day until late this afternoon or early evening when a 20% rain chance comes in, along with strong southerly winds. It is the edge of an approaching front. The high should get up to about 84° again.

Tonight: A 60% chance of rain, possibly a thunderstorm with strong winds after 1am. The storm is not likely to bring a lot of widespread rain, rather a lot of wind and thunder and lightning. Expect S-SE wind 15-25 mph and a low temp in the upper 60s.

Saturday: A 70% rain chance with severe storms and an inch of rain a good possibility. The wind will likely be 15-20 mph during the storms. The high temp should be about 81° after the front passes through.

The evening should bring light southerly winds, drying the area out a little, and the overnight low should be 66°.

Sunday will bring sunshine and upper 80s with light SW wind. Sunday evening will be nice with 70s the norm.

Next week we expect Monday to be nice but the threat of more spring rain seems to be around at 20-40% chances from Tuesday through Wednesday.
