The Weather



High yesterday was 85° The low this morning was 74°

Today: 60% chance of rain, with most of it before mid afternoon, otherwise cloudy and up to 84° this afternoon. The wind will be S-SE at 15-20 mph...a very windy day with the gusts up to 25 mph. The mostly morning to noon rain is expected now to bring just a half to ¾ of an inch.

Tonight: Partly cloudy with a low of 68° and S-SW wind relaxing to light at 5-10 mph.

Sunday: Sunny, with a high near 89° and W-SW wind very light and shifting to E-SE in the afternoon.

Sunday night will bring some clouds in, along with SE wind at 10-15 mph and a low temp of 71°.

Monday: Partly sunny with a high near 87° and a breezy S-SE wind 15-25 mph and gusting to 30. Overnight, the rain chances come back at 30%.


Tuesday: A 40% chance of rain again, though the sun will occasionally be out. The high temp should be 85° and the S-SW wind will be 10-15 mph.

Internal parasite workshop May 23

The Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will hold a Sheep and Goat Internal Parasite Management Workshop on May 23 at the Lampasas County Annex Conference Room at 409 S. Pecan St., Suite 104.

The event will run from 1- 5pm and costs \$15. Please call 512-556-8271 to register for this event by May 17. AgriLife Extension sheep and goat specialist Dr. Reid Redden, San Angelo, will be the featured speaker. Participants are encouraged to bring fecal samples from their animals in order to learn how to determine parasite load.

"This will be a key workshop for sheep and goat producers," said Heath Lusty, AgriLife Extension agent for agriculture and natural resources in Lampasas County. "Dr. Redden, one of the leaders in the industry, will be giving us an overview of how to identify, treat and stop the spread of parasites in ruminants."
