The Weather

TxDOT Meeting Today

The TxDOT Brownwood District will be conducting a virtual public meeting, along with a series of in-person meeting opportunities, for the proposed 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). These meetings offer the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed projects in the district. The virtual public meeting will include a pre-recorded presentation that provides the same information and program materials presented at the in-person public meetings.

The virtual presentation and materials will be available by noon on Monday, May 16, 2022. Visit www.txdot.gov and keyword search: "Brownwood District 2022 Rural TIP" to participate virtually, review materials and review the in-person public meeting details.

The Rural TIP includes all projects within the Brownwood District, which includes Brown, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Lampasas, McCulloch, Mills, San Saba, and Stephens counties. The Rural TIP includes all regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT District during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. A project in the Rural TIP is a project coming to your community and is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Rural TIP meetings are being held pursuant to Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program.

Texas Power Grid Ready for Summer

Leaders of the Texas power grid tried to assure the public Tuesday that the state's grid is ready for summer, when they forecast record-breaking demand for electricity during the hottest stretches.

Texas Public Utility Commission Chair Peter Lake, appointed by Gov. Greg Abbott after last year's deadly winter storm to regulate utilities and to oversee the Electric Reliability Council of Texas, said there will be more reserve power available to the grid this summer than in previous summers, a necessary cushion that Lake said reflects a different approach than before last February's disaster.

Lake spoke confidently about the grid's summer readiness on Tuesday alongside ERCOT President Brad Jones, who also said he has no concerns about this summer. Jones expressed some caution about "times that are dark and still," (*cont'd on back*)

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Tuesday shows the arrest of Dakota Fralin, 23, of Lampasas in the 900 block of E. 4th St. on 2 Lampasas PD warrants for aggravated assault w/deadly weapon at 10:33am. There were 2 reports of criminal trespass in the 1700 block of CTE, one at 10:47am and one at 11:13am. There was a minor accident in the 800 block of N. Key Ave. at 6:53pm and suspicious vehicles were reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 10:28pm and 10:29pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter for Tuesday shows Lometa with livestock issues. In Kempner there were livestock/animal issues, an alarm call, a reported disturbance, medical calls and civil matters. Out in the county there were civil matters, animal/livestock issues, a reported trespassing, a reported disturbance, a report of illegal dumping, a requested welfare check and reported threats. Deputies went into Cove on an animal issue, a repossession, and a fish & game call.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 40 year old Sarah Welch of Copperas Cove for DWI 2nd. Also arrested was 22 year old Cory Lakes of Sheppard, Texas for bail jumping and failure to appear.

(*cont'd from front*) meaning when the sun isn't shining to produce solar power and when wind isn't blowing enough to produce wind energy. They said their agencies are better prepared for times when there is likely to be a smaller share of energy generated by renewable sources.

Lake and Jones said they didn't have concerns about natural gas-fired power plants — the largest source of electricity generation on the power grid — despite having to ask Texans to reduce their power consumption on Friday after six power plants unexpectedly broke down.

Lake and Jones didn't reveal new information on Friday's outages beyond Jones noting that the six plants went down between noon and 4 p.m. that day.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on May 13th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 43 cases were brought to the court with 29 cases involving men, and 14 cases involving women.

Veronica Rosales failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Deshawn Baldwin of Pflugerville also failed to appear, on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG2, 1-4 grams. Macy Lunsford of Lampasas failed to appear on the charge of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, and Clara Hysell failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1, less than a gram.

There were 16 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1, with one being in a drug free zone. There were 9 cases for less than a gram, and 6 cases for 1-4 grams. There was 1 case for possession of a controlled substance PG 2, 1-4 grams and there were 3 DWI cases. There were three burglary cases and three cases of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle. There were 2 cases of theft of property and one case each for taking wildlife resources without consent, misappropriation of a trust fund, illegal dumping, unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon, theft of a firearm and evading arrest.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 3 cases of assault of a family member, 3 cases for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. There was one case each for indecency with a child/sexual contact, abandoning/endangering a child, stalking, and a motion to eliminate sexual registration.

Of the 44 cases, 11 were resolved with Lee Anthony Garcia being sentenced on 5 charges: for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle he received 12 months in the State Jail as well as court costs. For assault on a family member he received 5 years TDCJ. For theft of a firearm he received 12 months State Jail. For possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone Mr. Garcia was sentenced to 12 months State Jail, and for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1/4-200 grams he was sentenced to 5 years TDCJ. All days served will be credited toward his sentences. Todd Miller of Lampasas saw his aggravated assault w/deadly weapon charge dismissed. Michelle Lincoln of Copperas Cove was sentenced to 12 months State Jail on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Robert Trevino saw his case for misappropriation of a trust fund dismissed as did Juan Escalante for his case of DWI 3rd or more. Lee Bodie Myers plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance PG1, 1-4 grams and saw his probation extended for 2 years with the stipulation of drug treatment through MHMR. On the charge of evading arrest w/ vehicle, Dennis Martinez of Lampasas saw his probation extended for 2 years with the stipulation of ISF. And Donne Helmsley of Copperas Cove saw his motion to eliminate sexual registration granted.

All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials.
