Lampasas Fire Chief Visits Lampasas Radio Studios

Lampasas Fire Chief Jeff Smith (also the City of Lampasas Emergency Management Coordinator) visited the Lampasas Studios this morning to bring our listeners up to date on the testing of Nursing Home Patients in our community for COVID 19. The local fire departments are working under the Texas Department of Emergency Management, and the Texas Commission on Fire Protection. The



State felt that the local fire departments were the best option to get this done at a local level. Right now the fire department has submitted a request for resources, and is waiting on the state to provide more information, as well as supplies to get this completed.

When asked what the delay was, he said the shortage of tests at the beginning of the pandemic was one of the main reasons, but that is not an issue any longer.

Right now it looks like the Texas National Guard will be conducting the test on the patients and the staff at all nursing homes in the state.

Also, Chief Smith advised our listeners that while PPE is more readily available, the shortage now is gowns for the front line workers.

Summer School Plans for Lampasas ISD

Lampasas Radio received the following information from Dr. Kevin Bott at Lampasas ISD.

Lampasas ISD is planning to provide a virtual summer school this summer from June 1st - June 19th. Students who are recommended for extra support will have the opportunity to participate. We are providing online and paper options for these students (similar to our current COVID-19 school year format), and we will have summer school teachers in place to help support and remediate virtually during that time (approx. 8-12 students per teacher).

They are designed to engage students in meaningful content and mitigate student gaps in learning, as well as offer daily activities aligned with our Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills. LCRA, Hamilton County Electric Co-op Award \$20,240 Grant To Adamsville Volunteer Fire Dept.

LAMPASAS COUNTY, Texas – A \$20,240 grant from the Lower Colorado River Authority and Hamilton County Electric Cooperative will help the Adamsville Volunteer Fire Department purchase new rescue tools to help firefighters responding to car crashes and rural house fires.

This grant, combined with \$5,200 in matching funds from the department, will assist the volunteer fire department in upgrading its current hydraulic extractor to a cordless version to help firefighters assist victims in hard-to-reach areas.

“We’re in a very remote area,” said Sharon Watson, VFD treasurer. “A lot of these ditches where the accidents are occurring can’t be easily reached. We’re the only fire department in our county that’s not in a city, so if a vehicle is on fire, it could be the difference between life and death. It takes the Lampasas Fire Department about 30 minutes to get out there.”

In addition to the cordless extractor, the department will purchase a cordless ram and exhaust fan to clear out smoke during house fires, when firefighter visibility is impaired. Having tools like these readily available is essential to the department as the community continues to grow, Watson said.

“Our community should know their department has the right equipment to help them,” Watson said.

The Adamsville department, one of four fire departments in Lampasas County, serves a growing rural population.

The community grant is one of 28 grants awarded recently through LCRA’s Community Development Partnership Program, which provides economic development and community assistance grants to cities, counties, volunteer fire departments, regional development councils and other nonprofit organizations in LCRA’s wholesale electric and water service areas. The program is part of LCRA’s effort to give back to the communities it serves. Hamilton County Electric Cooperative is one of LCRA’s wholesale electric customers and a partner in the grant program.
