Some of the details include the fact that LHS will be having finals Tuesday thru Thursday, and Thursday is the last day of school for the year. That does include early release on that day for all students.

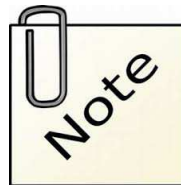
