A Visit with the Lampasas City Manager

Lampasas City Manger Finley de Graffenried was in the Lampasas Radio studios Wednesday morning for his weekly visit with Ronnie Witcher.

Mr. Witcher asked the City Manager about the ordinance being drafted for livestock in the city limits. Last week,

Mr. de Graffenried shared that Sammy Bailey will be drafting this ordinance. He stated that the city is "taking small steps in developing an ordinance that doesn't necessarily get in the way


of people having chickens/livestock in their backyard, but certain numbers of these animals are not compatible in a residential setting." The City Manager shared that other cities have ordinances that prohibit roosters in the city limits. The city will also identify species that are 'disruptive' such as guinea fowl.

Mr. De Graffenried said the format for this ordinance will be based on the "latitude such as distance to your neighbors and the size of the property you are on. A 1-2 acre lot in the city will have more latitude." In the Format they are currently drafting. He has advised the City Council that he would like this to be reviewed and updated and set up a time when the public can give input. He did not state that the public input would change the trajectory of this ordinance.

He did state that the ordinance regarding RV parking on the street seems to have a good level of compliance. However, for the truck drivers in our area, there is no publicly identified place to park your trucks.

This Monday, May 24th, the city will swear in the new Mayor, new Council Members and re-appoint the Municipal Judge. Also on Monday the Council will hear updates on the Hostess House upgrades, The Lampasas EDC and Capital Improvement Committees.

The pools have nearly full staff, so are expecting a nearly normal summer pool schedule.
