Bicycle Rider Killed – hit from behind on CR 2527

A man on a bicycle was hit by a pickup and killed in Lampasas
County on Sunday's noon hour.

DPS Troopers and Lampasas Co. Deputies and emergency services
responded at approximately 12:30pm to the intersection of east
FM580 and CR 2527.

Investigators said Douglas Wheeler, 56, was riding a bicycle when
the driver of a 2003 Chevrolet pickup hit Wheeler from behind and
killed him.

The driver, Curtis Windham Sr., age 68, was not injured.

The cause of the crash is unclear and is still under investigation,
but it's reason for extra caution for drivers.

**Know this, that bicycle riders have the same right to streets, roads
and highways as cars and trucks.** As warm weather arrives, there
will be more bicycles on the roadways, especially after school
ends.

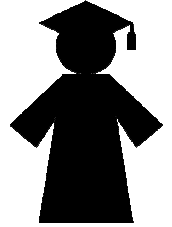
