The Weather

Today: Look for increasing clouds with a high temperature near 95°, and a 20% chance of storms this afternoon. Winds will be from the S at 5-15 mph with gusts of 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a low near 60°. Winds will become N at 10-15 overnight, gusting to 30 mph. There is a 40% chance of showers mainly before 1am.

Sunday: Mostly cloudy and the high temperature will climb to near 75° with a 20% chance of showers. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Monday Meetings

The Lampasas County Commissioner's Court will meet Monday at 9am in the Commissioner's courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, TAC HR Cheraun Balnkenship brief introduction to the Commissioners Court, approving a new member as an appointee to the Lampasas County Historical Commission and advertising on bids for a Precinct 3 Freightliner Truck.

The Lampasas City Council will hold meetings on Monday May 23rd with a special session beginning at 5:30pm to appoint a Mayor Pro Tem for the 2022-2023 term. This will be followed by the

workshop session which includes discussion regarding recap from the Council Work Session held on May 19th, discussion regarding salary comparison data among municipalities, and a capital improvement program report.

The regular session will begin at 6pm and will begin with presentations and proclamations. The agenda also includes the consent agenda, board and departmental reports, routine matters, the City Manager's Operational Report to include discussion of TxDOT, the business park, Ave. C, Kid Fish, the pool schedule, and budgeting.

In New Business there will be discussion and possible action regarding support of TxDOT project for improvements to the Lampasas Municipal Airport by Resolution in the amount of \$20,000 as the project share cost for the city. There will be discussion and possible action regarding the Fire Department Incident reporting and billing, discussion and acknowledgement of the fiscal year 2023-2028 CIP report, discussion and possible action 'regarding the first reading of an ordinance amending Appendix A of the City of Lampasas Code of Ordinances, Chapter 62. Solid Waste, Article III, billing Rates and Fees related to the collection of Solid Waste, providing for severability and repealer clauses and providing an effective date', discussion and possible action to seek proposals for Skate Park Pad at Campbell Park and discussion and possible action to direct staff to purchase fencing materials and award bid for installation to contractor in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.

Search for Escaped Convict

The Texas Department of Criminal Justice and numerous law enforcement agencies have concluded air and ground search in Leon County for convicted murderer Gonzalo Lopez.

According to TDCJ, the search is now going to be renewed and expanded with "a contingent of personnel" remaining in Leon County to conduct strategic searches outside the original perimeter.

“Anyone who has knowledge of Lopez’s location should come forward,” said Inspector General Cris Love. “Those found to be helping or harboring him not only will face arrest and prosecution, but I believe they are putting themselves in danger. Lopez has a complete disregard for human life and will do what it takes to avoid capture. We will take this investigation where ever it leads us until Lopez is back in custody.”

“Those with information on the suspect should call TDCJ OIG Crime Stoppers at 1-800-832-8477 or 936-437-5171,” said TDCJ. “Lopez is approximately 6’0” feet tall and 190 lbs and was last seen wearing white clothing in a wooded area off of Highway 7 in Leon County. A \$50,000 reward is being offered for information leading to the capture of Lopez.”
