Today: Cloudy early, then becoming mostly sunny with a high near 89° in the afternoon. The south wind will be 15-20 mph with gusts to 30.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy, a low of 73° and S-SE wind 15 mph and gusting.

Thursday: Partly sunny and up to about 87° with S-SE wind 15-20 mph and gusting to 30.

Catholic Church Caves In

The church that once represented the local worship place for Catholics, replaced later by St. Mary's Catholic Church, has fallen in from age and ruin. The old church sits next to the west entrance to the 4th



St. Bridge over Sulphur Creek. It goes back to 1885, rebuilt in 1940, burned and rebuilt again in 1972. In the years since it was the local Catholic Church, it has served as a St. Paul IME Church, a St. James Masonic Lodge, a garage, and in recent years, a reputed unofficial shelter for homeless people.

Some who seem to know, say the roof caved in sometime on Sunday, possibly due to wind and rain. Current owner Garry Milligan says he's been told by City officials that he has 48 hours to remove furnishings and contents from the property before it must be demolished. City Manager Finley deGraffenried said actually it must be done within 10 days, but it's all about safety as they consider the ruins to be dangerous to the public.

Lampasas Radio considers it another of Lampasas' historic landmarks that has been forgotten about for too long.

Now it's too late.

Hancock Park Course Cues Up for the Big One



The Annual Memorial Day Tourney starts on Saturday.

It's the 69th year of the tournament, officially known as the A.C. January Memorial Day Tournament.

A.C. January was the course pro and manager at Hancock Park starting back in the 50s and for many years after.

He had been on the tour himself many years before and this writer, as a young caddy way back when, heard him tell stories of playing with the likes of Ben Hogan.

Outside Lampasas, he might be remembered best as the father of former pro golfer Don January who was pretty famous back in the late 60s and into the 70s. He won the PGA Championship in 1967 and the Tournament of Champions in '68, along with many other big wins. In his senior years he won a number of those "Senior" tournaments before his retirement from the tours.

Van Berry, manager of Hancock Park Golf Course, says they now have 178 golfers for this year, down a little from last year. In 2018 there were 12 flites and this year it's 11.

The golfers come from all over Texas and some from other states. Van says there are lots of new names, and of course many of the local golfers are signed up to play.

Practice rounds are already started but tournament tee off starts at Saturday morning at 8am. The Championship Flite, with the best golfers, will tee off at 1pm.
