## The Weather



**High yesterday was 89° Low this morning was 64°**

The forecasters seem to agree the weekend will be pretty soggy. We know to expect showers and storms, the timing is the question. They say that storms may develop in North Central Texas by this afternoon, and they may develop quickly, and may produce hail. Central Texas should experience a lull tomorrow, although with the heat of the day some disorganized showers may result. The nightly storms are slated to continue Saturday night. Widespread rainfall totals of 2-4 inches are expected with 5 inch totals possible in areas. Creeks and streams may flood, so be aware.

**Today:** A partly sunny sky with a high temperature near 89°. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy with a low near 69°. Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph, gusting to 20 mph. Showers and storms are predicted after 10pm, a 30% chance.

**Saturday:** A slight chance of showers around daybreak, then again after 1pm, the forecasters put the probability at 40%. The skies will be partly sunny with a high temperature near 87°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph.

**Saturday night:** Mostly cloudy with a low near 69°, and a S-SE wind at 5-10 mph. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms in the evening.

**Sunday:** There is a 60% chance of showers and storms. with mostly cloudy skies and a high temperature near 82°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph.

**Sunday night:** Mostly cloudy with a low near 67° and a 50% chance of showers and storms continue. Winds will be light out of the south.

**Memorial Day:** Mostly cloudy skies with a high temperature near 83° and a 60% chance of precipitation. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

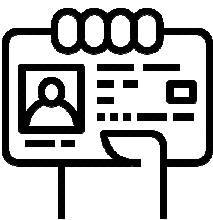

Texas will gradually reopen driver license offices with limited services starting Tuesday, Gov. Greg Abbott announced Thursday.

"I thank DPS for developing

this safe and strategic plan to open their offices and for launching a new appointment system to streamline our driver license services."

The four-phase plan for the opening of driver license **offices are** as follows:

**Phase 1:** Offices in DPS' Northwest and West Texas regions will reopen with limited services beginning May 26 Customers, who currently do not possess a Texas DL, CDL, learner permit or ID card, as well those who are in need of a drive test, can begin scheduling appointments in these two regions on May 22 at 1pm.

**Phase 2:** Offices in DPS' South and Central Texas regions will reopen with limited services beginning May 29. Customers, who currently do not possess a Texas DL, CDL, learner permit or ID card, as well those who are in need of a drive test, can begin scheduling appointments in these two regions on May 26 at 1pm.

**Phase 3:** Offices in DPS' North and Southeast Texas regions will reopen with limited services beginning June 3, 2020. Customers, who currently do not possess a Texas DL, CDL, learner permit or ID card, as well those who are in need of a drive test, can begin scheduling appointments in these two regions on May 29 at 1pm.

**Phase 4** will allow customers to schedule an appointment for all DL office transactions anywhere in the state and is expected to begin midsummer. DPS will announce details on this phase at a later date. Extension for expiration dates will remain in effect until phase 4 is implemented.

## Plan While You Can This Holiday Weekend

**AUSTIN** – As COVID-19 orders are relaxed in many parts of the state and more Texans return to the roads, TxDOT's "Plan While You Can" campaign is reminding drivers to make a sober ride part of their Memorial Day weekend plans.

"The long weekend should be an enjoyable start to summer, and we understand more and more

people are beginning to venture out," said TxDOT Executive Director James Bass. "But if you plan to drink alcohol, please know it is vital that you plan ahead for a sober ride. Without a doubt, planning for a sober ride home, will help prevent senseless tragedies and save lives."

During last year's Memorial Day weekend\* in Texas, there were 360 DUI-alcohol related traffic crashes in Texas. Those crashes killed 16 people and seriously injured another 34.

Driving under the influence of alcohol not only risks death or serious injuries, but it can also be costly. Drivers can face up to \$17,000 in fines and fees, jail time and loss of their driver's license. Instead of getting behind the wheel, here are some alternative options: Designate a sober driver, call a friend for a ride or use a ride share service, or spend the night.
