Today: Cloudy, with a high near 80°, an 80% chance of showers and storms, mainly in the afternoon, and winds will be E at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy with a 60% chance of showers and storms. The low temperature will be near 68° overnight. The S-SE wind will be near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Sunday: Cloudy with a 50% chance of showers and storm and a high temperature near 76°. Wind will continue from the SE at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Meetings Monday

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will meet Monday at 9am for a regular meeting.

The Agenda included the consent agenda, accounts payable & payroll, and recognition of Dr. Georgia Hay, the Lampasas County Health Authority.

The meeting will then go into Executive Session regarding the negotiation of legal responsibilities related to the completion of construction of the Lampasas County Jail & sheriff's office and the default by Kreuger Construction Company.

Following executive session, the agenda includes; final certificate of payment to finalize the new Law Enforcement Center, business with the River Hills Ranches Phase IIB, The county Hazard Mitigation Plan, Central County Services business, and an asbestos, lead, mold inspection/survey of the old jail.

The Lampasas City Council will meet beginning at 5:30pm on Monday for a special session to administer the oath of Office to newly elected mayor and members, reappointing the Municipal Court Judge and appointment of a mayor pro-tem.

This will be followed by a workshop session with discussion regarding the Covid-19 Pandemic, the livestock/fowl ordinance, the City council Work Plan, and Hostess House Improvements. The regular session will include citizen comments, the consent agenda, board and department reports, routine matters, the City Manager's Operational report to include a report on the Court of Appeals, Rugged Sweep, and storm impacts. In new business, there will be discussion of an ordinance amending guarantee of performance, a voluntary annexation of Hillside Acres, for the Lampasas Police Dept. to purchase a vista-com recording solution, and a proposed feasibility assessment to preserve New Hope Baptist Church in the amount of \$9800. Council will then go into Executive Session, relating to utilities, and then return to regular session for action on executive session.

Summer Reading Program

The Lampasas Public Library will be offering a summer reading program this year, though it will be a little different than in years past. The theme this year is "Tails & Tales" so all programming will be animal-related! They will have virtual story times and outdoor programs (see calendar of events for individual programs). This year, they are also providing 12 weekly episodes of "The Reading Road Trip: Animal Exploration" on the library's Facebook page; associated activities/crafts will be available for pick-up at the library. Beginning May 17, children ages 3 years and older, as well as teens, can sign up at the library for the summer reading program. Pool Schedule

The City of Lampasas has released a City Pool Schedule for this summer.



Beginning June 8th Hanna Springs Pool will be closed on Sunday and Monday, and open Tuesday-Saturday from noon -7pm. Water Aerobics will be available starting June 8th on Tuesday and Thursday from 7-8pm, but you must purchase a card that is good for 8 visits. During Spring Ho, the pool will be open from noon to 5pm on July 6th-9th. Other dates are on July 24th the pool will close at 6pm. July 30th will have movie night beginning at 8pm.

Hancock Springs Pool will be open Memorial Day weekend beginning on Saturday, May 29th from noon to 7pm, then Sunday and Monday, the 30th and 31st from noon to 5pm. Beginning June 5th, Regular hours will be Monday-Wednesday closed, open 12-7 Thursday through Saturday, and Sundays noon-5pm. During Spring Ho, Hancock Springs Pool will be open from July 8th-10th from noon to 5pm. There will be a moonlight swim on July 24th from 7-11pm.

Each year, the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor may each appoint two students, and each State Senator and each State Representative may appoint one student to receive an initial conditional scholarship award.
