There's no limit to the purchase of these type products. You can also get any appliances that display the ENERGY STAR on them for the same tax free purchase. As long as they cost less than \$6,000 for AC units and \$2,000 for other appliances.

## LCRA Board Approves Budget

The LCRA Board of Directors on Wednesday approved a business plan of more than \$1 billion for fiscal year 2020 and also approved \$435 million for capital spending in the fiscal year for energy, water and public service projects to support growth in Texas.

The LCRA is the primary wholesale provider of electricity in Central Texas, along with managing the lower Colorado River and six Highland Lakes. LCRA Transmission Services Corporation (TSC) is also one of the largest electric transmission service providers in Texas.

As one of the largest public power providers in the state, LCRA is helping meet the increasing need for power in Texas. They have long term wholesale electricity contracts retail utilities, including cities and electric coops.

LCRA TSC plans capital spending of about \$342 million in FY 2020 and, over the next five years, intends to invest about \$1.4 billion in building and improving transmission facilities. Over the next fiscal year, LCRA TSC will undertake numerous projects to increase reliability and respond to the Electric Reliability Council of Texas system needs.

LCRA also plans investments to increase regional water supplies and to continue to maintain and invest in its system of dams, critical for water supplies and flood management in the basin. Over the next five years, LCRA has budgeted more than \$63 million for development of new water supply projects and more than \$40 million for dam rehab projects to help ensure the dams continue to operate properly.
