The Weather



The High Yesterday: 83° **The Low This morning** 61°

Today: Cloudy skies with a 40% chance of showers and storms this afternoon. The high temperature will top out near 84°. The wind will be E at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for cloudy skies and a low temperature near 67°. There is an 80% chance of precipitation and wind will be from the SE near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tuesday: The cloudy skies continue with the 80% chance of showers and storms, mostly in the morning hours. The high temperature will be near 82°. The wind will be from the S at 15-20 mph, gusting to 25 mph.

Record Year for Boys & Girls Club Fundraiser

Once again the Lee Hoffpaur Barns were the site of a gala fundraiser for the Lampasas Boys & Girls Club. The annual Dinner & "Barn Dance" took place at the Hoffpaur Ranch several miles west of town on FM 580 West on Saturday evening. After cocktails and a dinner of prime rib and chicken, host Lee Hoffpaur took over and a live auction began that saw trips, coveted event tickets, large numbers of guns, hours of "cedar mulching," hunting expeditions, a luxury purse and a long list of

things. It even included a chocolate Lab puppy that brought over \$8,000.

When it was over, the tally went to \$450,000 raised for the local Boys and Girls Club. According to Lee Hoffpaur, "it takes roughly \$300,000 to run the club for a year. He says "over 250 kids attend the club on a daily basis and some would not get a hot meal, help with homework, or access to computers and much more without the organization."

After the auction, there was music and dancing and fun for all with the Branded Heart band and lots of frivolity.

The Lampasas County Commissioner's Court met this morning at 9am in the Commissioner's Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The agenda also includes the consent agenda, board and departmental reports, routine matters, and the City Manager's Operational Report to include discussion of the TxDOT meetings, the business park, Ave. C, Kid Fish, the pool schedule, and budgeting.

The City of Lampasas has released their pool schedule for this summer.

The Hanna Springs pool will open May 28th from 12pm-7pm and May 29th and 30th from 12pm-5pm. The pool will be closed on May 31st. Beginning June 1st, the regular hours for Hanna Springs will be: closed Sunday and Monday, and open Tuesday-Saturday from 12pm to 7pm. The pool will, however, close at 3pm on June 4th.

For Spring Ho, the pool will be open from 12pm-5pm on July 5th through July 8th, and closed except for Spring Ho activities on July 9th.

Water aerobics start June 7th and will be on Tuesday and Thursday from 7-8pm (you must purchase a card for \$40 that is good for 8 visits).
